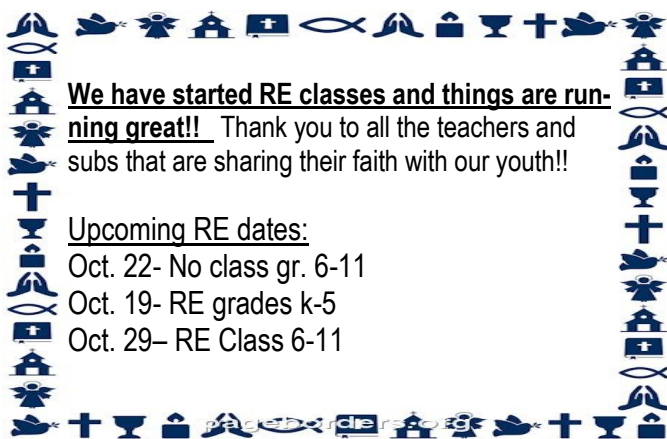
Raffle drawing winners are posted daily at the church.
