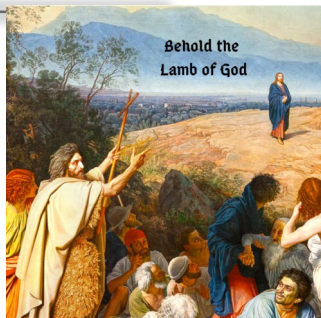

SACRAMENTS

If you would like to inquire or receive a Sacrament, please contact **Fr. James 218.463.2441**.

- **Baptism:** Beginning of spiritual life, freed from original sin and any personal sin. (John 3:5)
- **Matrimony:** **Contact Fr. James 6 mos. prior to prepare.** Priest unites man and woman together (Matthew 19:6)
- **Anointing of the Sick:** Call for the priests of the Church and have them pray and anoint them with the oil in the name of the Lord. Prayers of the faithful will save the sick, and the Lord will raise them up; and anyone who has committed sins will be forgiven." The Church has the great challenge of continuing the work of Jesus' healing in the world. Please know of the Church's prayers for you and the one you love who is ill.
- **Holy Communion:** Receiving the body & blood of Jesus allows us to grow closer to him. (John 6:56)
- **Reconciliation:** God forgives and fills us with grace and joy that help to lead us away from sin. (Mark 2:5)
- **Confirmation:** Bishop anoints using "chrism" oil while the gifts of the Holy Spirit are received. (John 20:22)
- **Holy Orders:** Men are ordained (Bishop, Priest, Deacon) and receive grace and power to serve God.

Following any necessary processes defined in canon law, the bishop will decide upon configurations and communicate transparently to the parishes. The transition to new parish configurations are implemented over a period of months.

3rd Sun of Ordinary Time: Prep for the Gospel In today's Gospel, we see Jesus's reaction to the news that his cousin John has been arrested: he goes into seclusion back at home in Galilee, maybe for one last visit home with Mary, and then begins gathering the band of followers who will become his apostles. In Israel at this time, students sought out their teachers, but Jesus reverses that. He calls first Peter and Andrew, and then James and John, saying "Come, follow me." Apparently his words strike some deep chord, because these rough, work-hardened fishermen put down their nets and immediately go with Jesus. James and John apparently even got out of the boat they were in, leaving their father behind! These men responded to Jesus's call without hesitation, and their lives, and the history of the world, were changed because of that. Jesus also calls each one of us. Just as he did on the shore of the Sea of Galilee, he meets us where we are and extends the invitation to follow him. We might think that we don't have the necessary gifts or talents to do great things for the kingdom, but who would have thought that ordinary fishermen would become the greatest fishers of men? *by FORMED.org*
