1. The Watermelon Seed

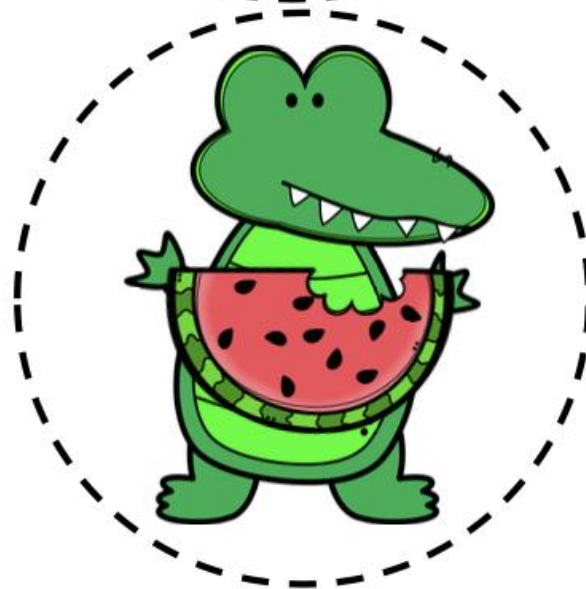
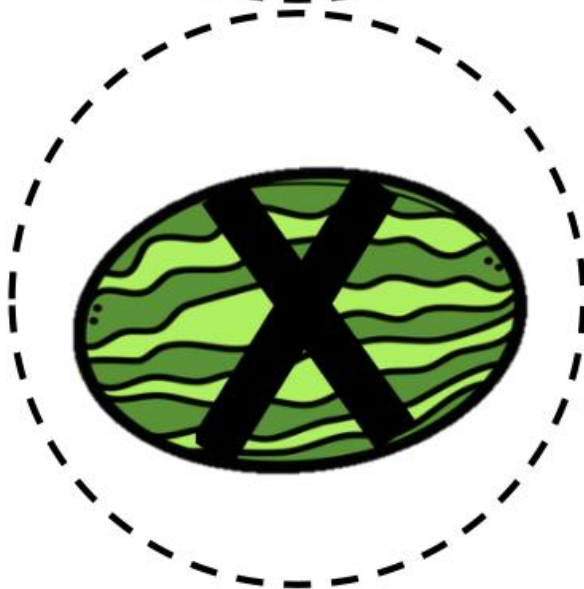
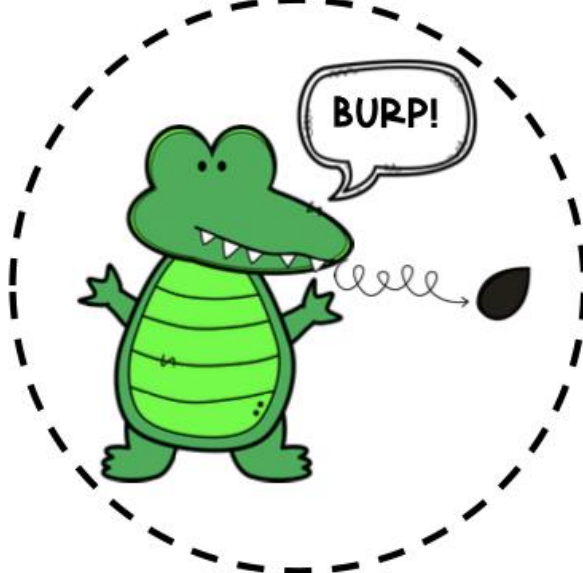
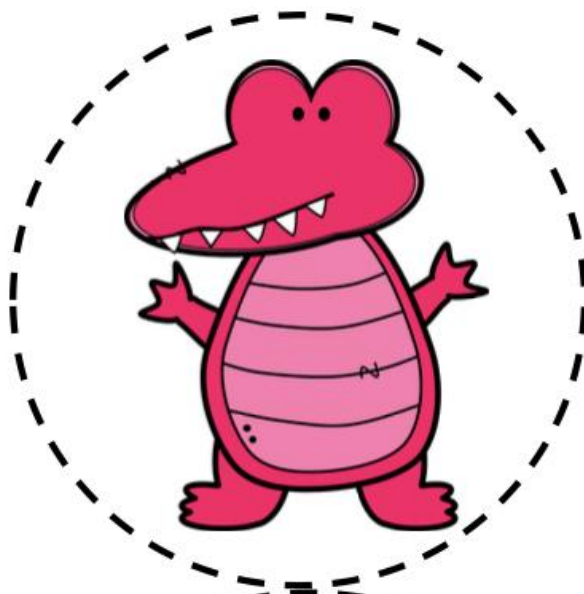
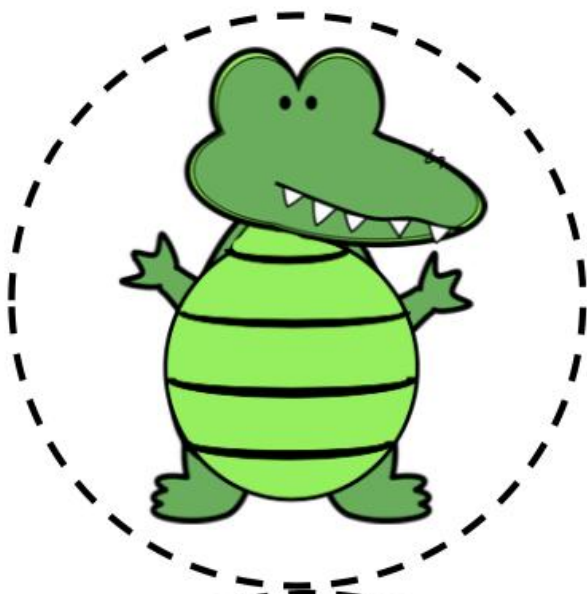

7. We will showcase our videos to the class the second week of school. Students are always very excited to see each other's videos!

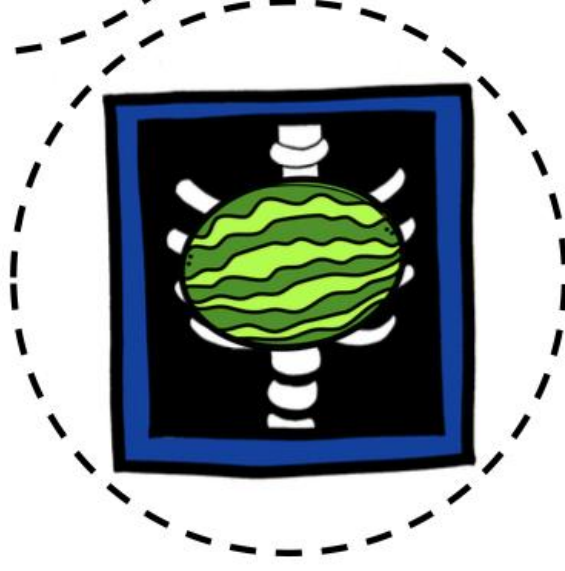
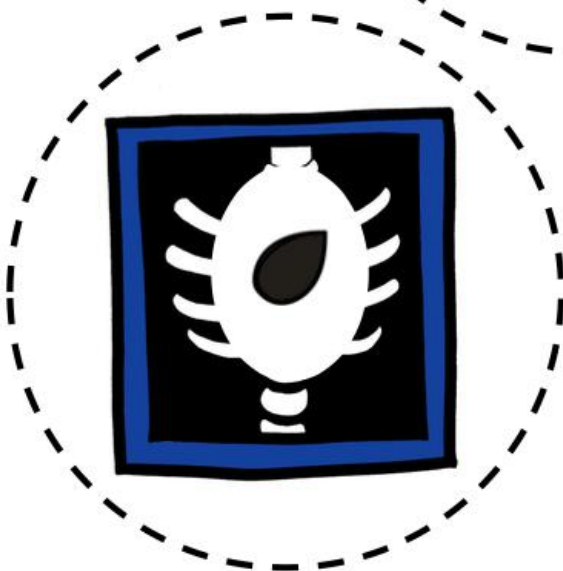
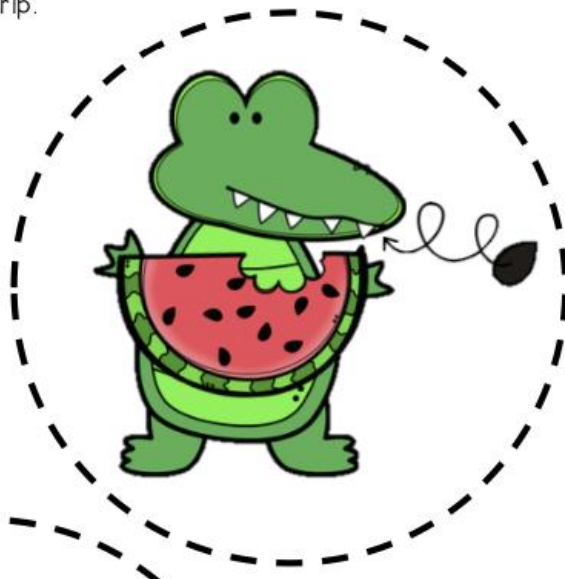
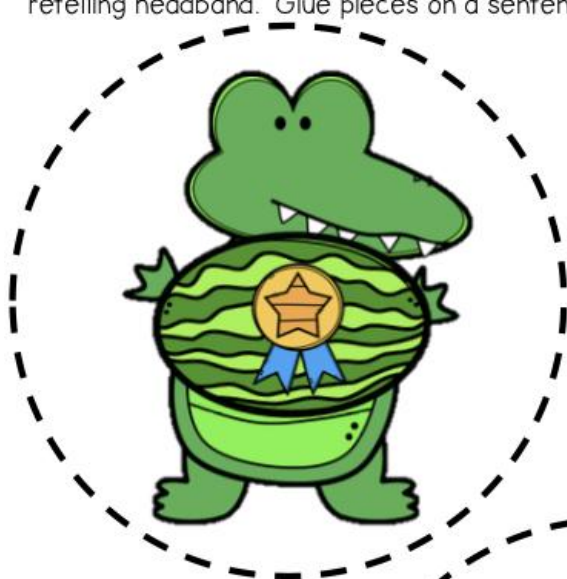
2. Not a Box

5. Make sure your child's name is on both papers.

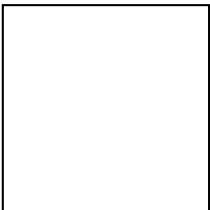
