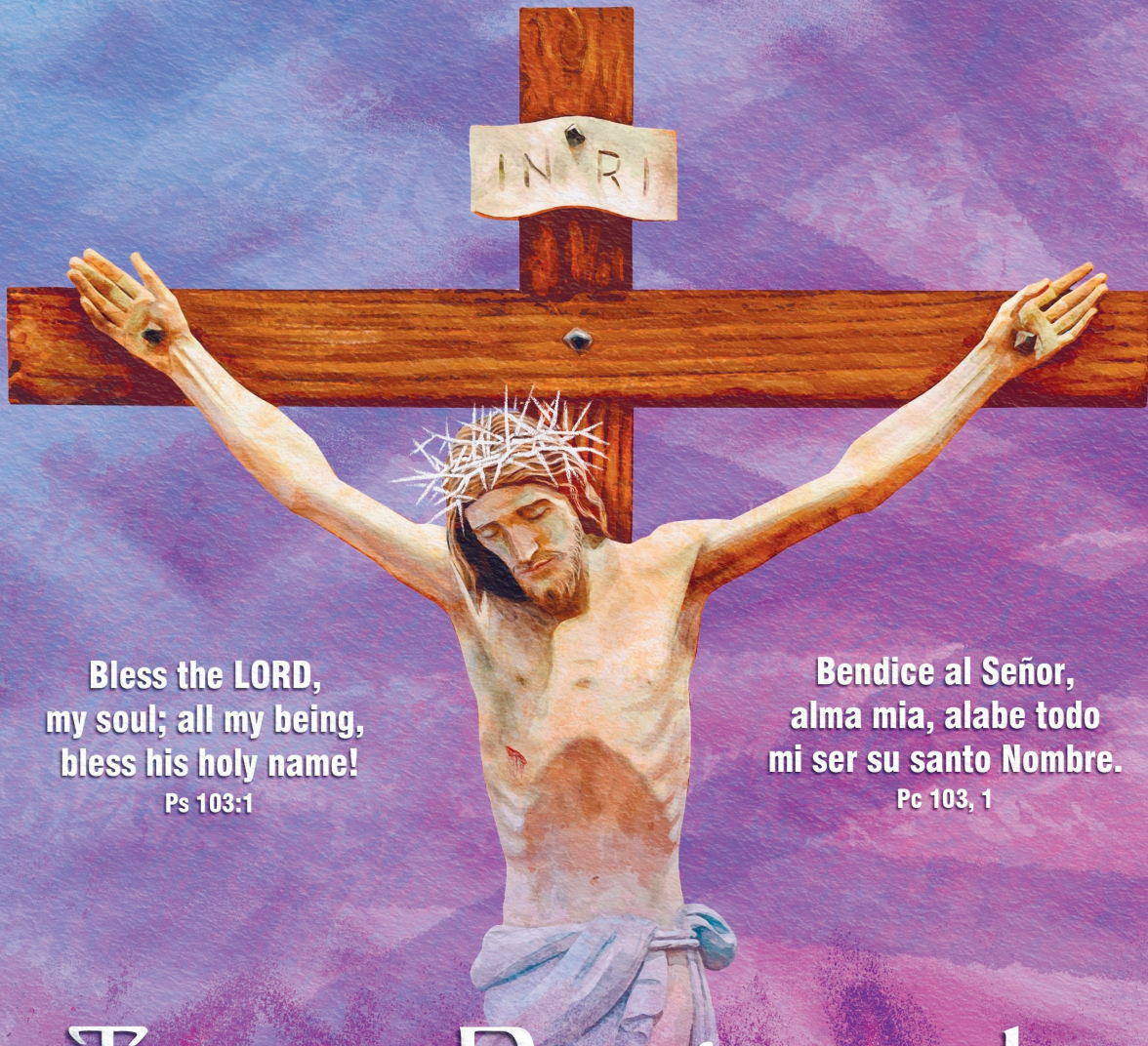

## Weekly Notes

### TRANSFIGURATION

People have been coming into the Church at Easter Vigil for almost 2000 years. Some become baptized, confirmed, and receive their first Eucharist that night. Others coming from a different Christian community who are already baptized are received into the Catholic Church through the sacraments of Confirmation and First Eucharist after a profession of faith. It's an exciting time for those coming into the faith. But they do not come to the fullness of the faith in a vacuum. They come into the church through a process called RCIA, which is an acronym for the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults.

Major parts of the Rite occur during Lent. With the rest of us, those coming into full communion begin Lent with the reception of ashes on Ash Wednesday. At this time they promise to repent and be faithful to the Gospel. Next, during a Mass of the First Sunday of Lent they participate in the Rite of Sending. In this part of RCIA the catechumens and candidates are called forward to be sent to the Bishop or his representative by the Pastor. Many of you saw this a few weeks ago at the 5:30pm Vigil Mass. When those sent arrive at the Cathedral they participate in the Rite of Election. In this part of RCIA the catechumens and candidates become the Elect. The bishop asks, "Do you wish to enter fully into the life of the Church through the sacraments of baptism, confirmation, and the Eucharist?" They respond, "We do." Then they offer their names by writing them in a book where they are enrolled and admitted into the last part of RCIA as the elect. It's similar to applying to a school and getting accepted, except this school is better because it is the school of faith through the Catholic Church with Christ himself as the teacher. He will teach the mysteries through the rest of RCIA in Lent.

At the end the bishop prays, "My dear elect, you have set out with us on the road that leads to the glory of Easter. Christ will be your way, your truth, and your life. Until we meet again for the scrutinies, walk always in his peace." Next week I'll pick up where I left in explaining the rest of RCIA. In the meantime please pray for the Elect of our parish, so that they might heartily enter into the sacred mysteries through the process by walking with our Lord Jesus.

### TRANSFIGURACIÓN

La gente ha estado entrando a la Iglesia en la Vigilia Pascual durante casi 2000 años. Algunos se bautizan, se confirman y reciben su primera Eucaristía esa noche. Otros provenientes de una comunidad cristiana diferente que ya están bautizados son recibidos en la Iglesia Católica a través del sacramento de la Confirmación y la Primera Eucaristía después de una profesión de fe. Es un momento emocionante para aquellos que vienen a la fe. Pero no llegan a la plenitud de la fe en el vacío. Llegan a la iglesia a través de un proceso llamado RICA, que es un acrónimo del Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos.

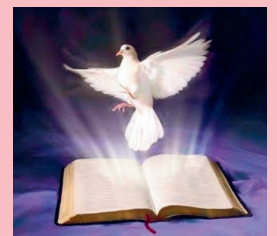
Las partes principales del Rito ocurren durante la Cuaresma. Con el resto de nosotros, los que entran en plena comunión comienzan la Cuaresma con la recepción de cenizas el Miércoles de Ceniza. En este momento prometen arrepentirse y ser fieles al Evangelio. A continuación, durante la misa del primer domingo de Cuaresma participan en el Rito de envío. En esta parte de RICA los catecúmenos y los candidatos son convocados para ser enviados al Obispo o su representante por el Pastor. Muchos de ustedes vieron esto hace unas semanas en la Misa de Vigilia de las 5:30 pm. Cuando los enviados llegan a la Catedral, participan en el Rito de Elección. En esta parte de RICA los catecúmenos y los candidatos se convierten en los elegidos. El obispo pregunta: "¿Deseas entrar plenamente en la vida de la Iglesia a través de los sacramentos del bautismo, la confirmación y la Eucaristía?" Ellos responden: "Nosotros sí". Luego, ofrecen sus nombres escribiéndolos en un libro donde están inscritos y admitidos en la última parte de RICA como elegidos. Es similar a postularse a una escuela y ser aceptado, excepto que esta escuela es mejor porque es la escuela de fe a través de la Iglesia Católica con el mismo Cristo como maestro. Él enseñará los misterios a través del resto de RICA en Cuaresma.

Al final, el obispo reza: «Mi querido elegido, has salido con nosotros por el camino que conduce a la gloria de la Pascua. Cristo será tu camino, tu verdad y tu vida. Hasta que nos volvamos a encontrar para los escrutinios, caminemos siempre en su paz ". La próxima semana continuaré donde lo dejé para explicar el resto de RICA. Mientras tanto, ore por los elegidos de nuestra parroquia, para que puedan entrar con entusiasmo en los misterios sagrados a través del proceso caminando con nuestro Señor Jesús.

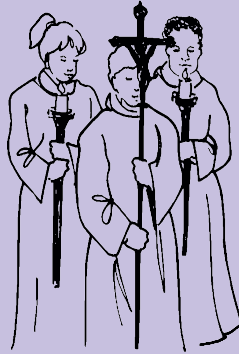

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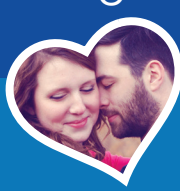
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
