# **Confirmation Preparation 2023-2024**

The Confirmation Program serves to prepare candidates for full communion into the Roman Catholic Church by calling them into full, active, and conscious participation in their spiritual community of St. Francis and the universal church.

Through a period of reflection, prayer, and study, the Confirmandi choose to follow Christ and to commit to living as witnesses, in word and deed, to the Gospel throughout the remainder of their lives.

Confirmation is a Sacrament. Sacraments are external signs of God's grace in the life of a believer. To participate in the Sacrament of Confirmation is to participate in becoming an external sign of God's grace in our world. In the Sacrament of Confirmation, we are "given full outpouring of the Holy Spirit as once granted to the Apostles on the day of Pentecost. We become witnesses to the Gospel, because, through the grace of the Sacrament, we are given the: special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by word and action as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ boldly, and never to be ashamed of the Cross."

# The Role and responsibility of the Parents and the Sponsor

Sponsors are those who will help the Confirmation candidate live his or her baptismal promises. It is the responsibility of the sponsor to:

- help the candidate understand and appreciate the Sacrament of Confirmation and have the right intentions for receiving it.
- help the candidate prepare for Confirmation by encouraging him or her to pray, to participate in the sacraments— especially the Eucharist—and to become actively involved in the life of their parish community.
- present the candidate for Confirmation and continue to assist the confirmed person in living a Christian life.

### **Requirements of the Candidates**

These are the MINIMUM requirements to be met to be recommended for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

- > Candidate professes belief and has basic understanding of God, the Trinity and the Holy Eucharist.
- ➤ Attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation
- > Frequent Confession
- > Memorized the basic prayers; the Our Father, the Hail Mary, the Glory Be, the Nicene Creed.
- > Selection of a sponsor who is a confirmed, practicing Catholic who will walk the journey with you.
- > Selection of a Saint's name as your Confirmation name and an essay of why you chose the name/saint.
- ➤ Completion of Service Projects
- ➤ Participate in FOCUS Youth Ministry's monthly meetings, activities, and fundraisers.
- > Attendance of the Confirmation Retreat
- > Final Interview with the priests and/or Director of Religious Education
- ➤ Confirmation Letter to the pastor
- > Pass both the Midterm and Final Exams.

- > Remember your Sunday Mass obligation.
- All students are required to attend scheduled classes on time and complete Google Classroom assignments. All students are only permitted 3 absences; please read the parent handbook.

- 6. Final Exam will be May 5, 2024
