My Dear Parish Family,

"News" travels fast around the parish, but I wanted you to hear from me what has been going on. Two weeks ago on Friday I was feeling a little tired and had no energy. I went to lunch with a friend and then came home and thought I should take a little rest. I spent most of the day and evening in bed. Saturday morning, I got up a little late but made it over for Mass. The morning was a little shaky, and as I celebrated the Mass, I knew something was wrong. As I elevated the paten and the chalice, I was shaky and afraid that I was going to spill the Precious Blood, but I made it through the Mass. When I got back to the rectory, Lois Mullins came to check on me followed by Kim Yaney, the "Church Nurse." After some conversation it was strongly suggested that I call my kidney doctor who recommended that I go to the ER and get checked out.

After almost seven hours in the ER I was admitted and with many blood draws and pokes they could not figure out what was going on with me. They even tested me for COVID-19 as I had a slight fever. Saturday evening the fever spiked to 102.9 so they knew there was an infection somewhere in my body. On Sunday they still were not sure what was going on so they did a CT Scan which the doctor looked at on Monday and was finally able to diagnose my problem: Diverticulitis. Tuesday, I was able to go home on a liquid/soft-food diet. It was good to be home where I could rest my body and my arm from the unending pokes for blood draws. I had lots of pains to offer up!

This past week I have had follow-up doctors' appointments, trying to get a plan of action into place. Please keep me in your prayers. Thank you to everyone who has sent me cards, Mass Cards, gift cards, and their prayers. I appreciate all your kindness.

DISPENSATION FROM MASS EXTENDED

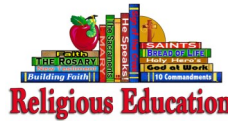
On Monday, August 3, 2020, a statement was issued by the bishops, which reads: "While commending our pastors and pastoral life coordinators who have gone to great lengths to assure safe worship spaces in our churches, due to the increase in the COVID-19 cases in our state, the Indiana bishops have decided to **extend the dispensation from the obligation of Sunday Mass attendance beyond August 15 until November 1, 2020, unless further developments determine otherwise.**"
