ANNOUNCEMENTS

UPDATES & REMINDERS

Just a few reminders and updates as we continue to adapt and work to uphold the Diocesan Guidelines:

- * Masks must be worn in the church. Your mask should cover BOTH your nose and your mouth. Fr. Bob falls in the High Risk category, so please be considerate of his health, and the health of others in our parish at higher risk and do your part by wearing your mask properly.
- * If you are a single individual attending Mass, please don't be afraid of the middle seat. If a single individual has already taken an end seat and you are the next person to sit in the pew, please take the middle seat so that we are not crawling over one another to fill the pews, and can make the most of our seating. This is especially important now as more return to Mass and our church maximum capacity is limited. We don't want to turn anyone away, especially if we have empty seats because we haven't "moved in".
- * Dismissal. We are changing the way we dismiss from the pews. You are free to go at the end of Mass without waiting for an Usher to dismiss you, and you may leave from whichever door you choose. PLEASE, maintain social distancing from people not in your family as you leave. If you wish to say hello to Fr. Bob or Fr. Neil after Mass, they will be outside the main doors of the church to greet people. Social distancing and masks are required.
- * Singing is NOT allowed at this time as a congregation. Please sing in spirit within your hearts, not out loud, or we will have no choice but to go back to instrumental music only and reciting the Psalm and Alleluia.


