# The Advent Wreath



The wreath has four candles, **three purple** or **violet** and one **rose**. On the First Sunday and Week of Advent, we light the first candle and then an additional candle on each Sunday until Christmas. Purple is a royal color, reflecting the kingship of Christ and also repentance. **The rose candle, lighted on the Third Sunday of Advent, represents joy.** Thus, the colors of the candles illustrate the themes of Advent: kingship, repentance and joy. The candles also remind us that the incarnation has transformed the darkness of hated and evil into the light of joy and love.
