HOLY WEEK

There will be a meeting in the Church at 7:00 PM on Tuesday, April 16th for everyone participating in the Easter Triduum: Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Ushers, Altar Servers and music ministers.



On Holy Thursday the Church celebrates Jesus' final meal with his disciples and the institution of the eucharist. The regular Eucharistic ritual is enhanced by the rite of foot-washing, recalling how Jesus washed his disciples feet (Jn 13:1-20). After the liturgy, the consecrated bread is transferred to a side altar and kept in a tabernacle there for adoration. Then the altar is stripped.



Good Friday is the only day of the year on which Mass is not said. The altar is bare, and the liturgy consists of proclaiming the passion story from John's Gospel, intercessions, veneration of the cross and a communion service with bread consecrated on Holy Thursday.
