

The Transfiguration of the Lord AUGUST 6, 2023





A Message from Fr. George




One of the great memories that I will hold of my time at Saint Vincent Martyr is our Sunday night broadcasts – or as some have called it – Fr. George Unplugged. For those who do not know the history of the broadcast, it started during the Pandemic. We wanted to find ways to keep our community connected to one another and to the parish, and the broadcast was one of those ways. We continued beyond the pandemic right up to the end of this past June. On our final evening together, I shared a list of ten themes that consistently showed up in my messages. You might even call them my rule of life! Here they are in written form for your consideration.

- 1. Believe with all your heart that you are a beloved child of God. God loves you totally, unconditionally and constantly, even with your faults. You are fully known and fully loved. Let Jesus Christ awaken this truth within you, and you will find joy, strength, and purpose in your life.
- 2. **Pray daily to the Holy Spirit** Veni Sancte Spiritu, Come Holy Spirit! Allow the Holy Spirit to be the change in you, shaping and forming you in the image of Jesus Christ. Let the Spirit lead and guide you and be ready for anything!
- 3. Live in the flow of love shared by the Father, Son and Spirit. When you accept the invitation to enter that flow you will have amazing experiences of God's grace at work in your life, providing for you in your need, sustaining in your times of trial and working all things for your good.
- 4. **Pray like our Blessed Mother**, with your whole being, with a heart full of love for God in whom we live and move and have our being. Pray with holy words, with song, with the movement of your body, with your mind and imagination. Pray always!

- 5. Embrace the contemplative way, taking time to sit and be in the presence of God. Explore solitude, stillness, and silence as ways of entering more deeply into the mystery of God. Develop a contemplative practice that will quiet your life and ground you God's love.
- 6. Act from a stance of oneness with God in Christ through the Holy Spirit. Strive to respond rather than react to those things in life that ruffle your feathers. Live the blessed life of a peacemaker, choosing to do no harm in thought, word, or action.
- 7. Take up the challenge of our Holy Father Francis and invest yourself in building a Culture of Encuentro (Encounter). Look for opportunities to serve your brothers and sisters, to be fully and really present to them with care and compassion. Roll up your sleeves and get involved.
- 8. Expand the circle of who you know and who you talk to. Make room in your heart for folks that are from different cultures or ethnic backgrounds, or who hold different creeds and viewpoints. Try to live judgement free in your dealing with others, avoiding stereotypes and prejudices.
- 9. Maintain an attitude of gratitude, being thankful for who you are and what you have in the moment, believing that it is enough for your happiness. Express your gratitude to God by embracing a stewardship way of life, sharing what God has given you with others.
- 10. Center your life on the Eucharist. Be nourished by the Word of God. Become what you receive the real presence of Christ in the world. When you receive the Lord, know that you are made one with Him and with all who live in Him and that's everybody and everything. Amen!
