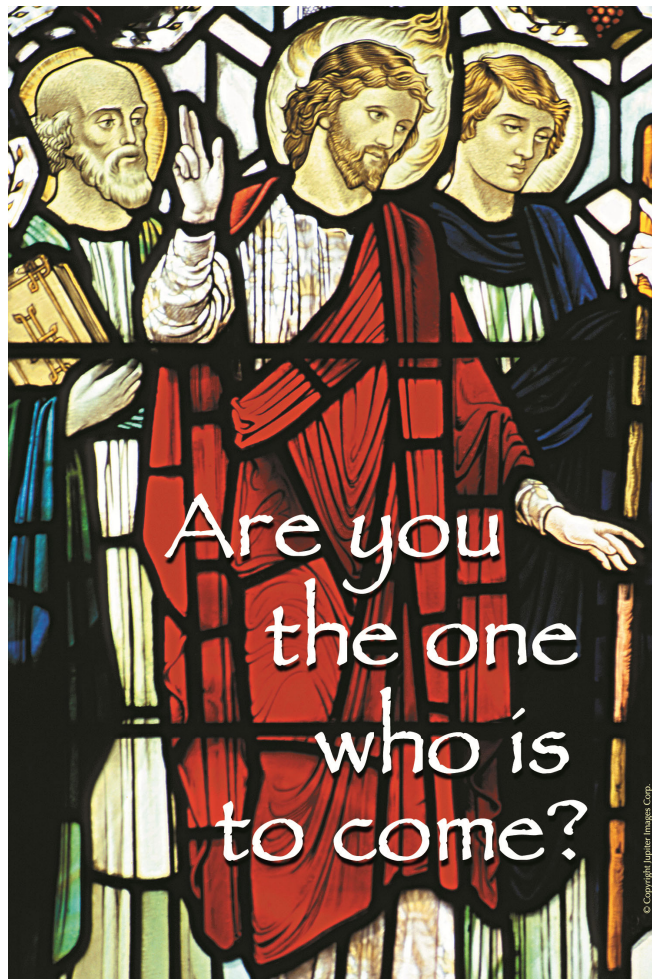

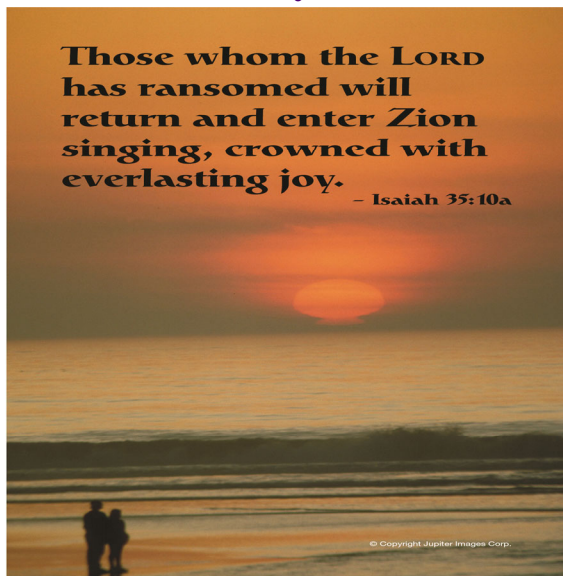

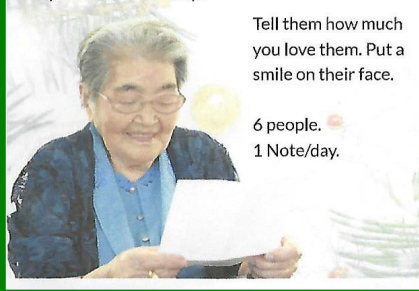

Profession of Faith

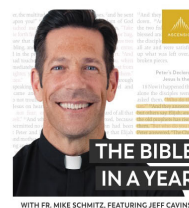
