PARISH MINISTRIES

St. Thomas Parish,

This weekend we celebrate a feast that occurs each year on June 29, which happens to fall on a Sunday this year: the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. These two towering figures of the early Church could not have been more different! Peter, the fisherman from Galilee, was impulsive and heartfelt, while Paul was a scholarly Pharisee turned tireless missionary. Together, they form the foundation of the Church's mission, one by his witness and leadership in Jerusalem, the other by his preaching and outreach across the Gentile world. Their statues and stained glass windows are rarely seen separated from one another. Take a look at their windows in our church, the ones right above the altar on the uppermost level."

The Gospel we hear today takes us to a key moment in Peter's life when he boldly proclaims Jesus as "the Christ, the Son of the living God." In response, Jesus names him the rock on which the Church will be built. Of course, Peter's confession of faith is not the end of the story. He would continue to struggle, deny, fall, and be forgiven. But in that moment, his openness to God's revelation points to what it means to be a disciple: to let the truth of Christ transform us.

Paul's journey echoes similar themes. Once a persecutor of Christians, he was radically transformed by an encounter with the risen Lord. From that moment on, his life became a tireless testimony to grace, proclaiming Christ crucified and risen, no matter the cost.

Thanks to all who were able to join in our Eucharistic Procession last Sunday for Corpus Christi! Take a look at some of the pictures on the website and the Facebook page.

PILGRIMAGE

When the time came for the Transfiguration of Christ, Jesus took three of his disciples to "a high mountain by themselves," indicating that the sacred mysteriousness of this moment was something best experienced apart from the routine of ordinary life. This is the principle behind the act of pilgrimage: a journey to a place of spiritual significance, undertaken by one who is seeking closeness to Heaven while still on Earth.

Christian pilgrimages really began in the fourth century, when churches in the Holy Land were constructed in locations associated with the life of Christ. Throughout the centuries, pilgrims have likewise flocked to sites of Marian apparitions, miracles, and to places connected with the lives of saints. Some of the most iconic pilgrimage destinations include Fatima, Lourdes, and the Santiago de Compostela in Spain.
