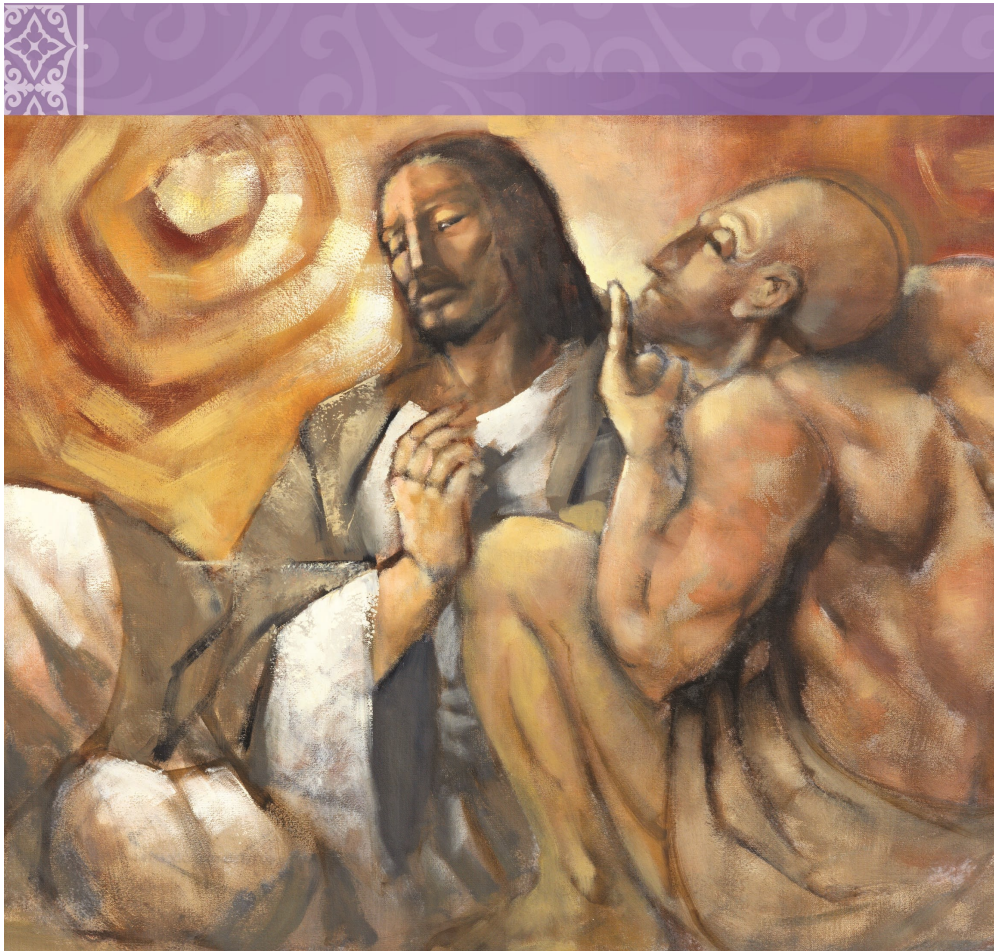

## 1ST SUNDAY OF LENT

"The tempter approached and said to him, 'If you are the Son of God, command that these stones become loaves of bread.' He said in reply, 'It is written: One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God.'" Mt 4: 1-4

# PARISH MINISTRIES

St. Thomas Parish,

We enter into this first weekend of Lent, ashes washed clean from our foreheads from a few days ago, and prepared for the season ahead of us. Remember what we heard from the ministers on Wednesday, either "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you will return," or "Repent, and believe in the Gospel." Either phrase reminds us what this holy season is all about, which is primarily a return. An intentional turning back to the Lord with our whole heart. Lent is an annual grace-filled opportunity to refocus, to clear away what distracts us, and to remember who we are and whose we are.

I asked the congregation at Mass this past Tuesday, if I were to create a list of what tempts us, what are our temptations, what might be included on that list? This weekend's Gospel shows us Jesus in the desert facing his own temptations. Before he begins his public ministry, he enters into silence and struggle. The desert, while it is a place of testing, it is also a place of encounter with God. Stripped of comfort and distraction, Jesus reveals what truly sustains life: "One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God." Lent invites us into our own "desert" moments, those moments to acknowledge our temptations, so that we can rediscover that same truth, which is ultimately that we rely on God to sustain us.

As it turns out, the temptations Jesus faces may not be so different from our own. The temptation to rely only on material things, to seek control rather than trust, to give our hearts to something other than God. Each time, Jesus responds by placing his trust firmly in the Father. He shows us that holiness is about daily fidelity, about choosing God again and again.

How do we approach these forty days? As we begin, it's important to remember that the sacrifices we make are for the purpose of making space for God to do something new within us. Lent, of course, is a journey that leads to Easter, and every small sacrifice, every extra prayer, every act of charity prepares our hearts to celebrate the victory of Christ more fully. Let us walk this path with intention, trusting that if we remain close to the Lord in the desert, He will lead us to the joy of the Resurrection.

This week, dozens of people throughout the parish and school will begin their first meetings for "Gather for Grace." The theme over the six weeks of group discussions and homilies will be the healing Jesus Christ can bring to us and the world. As I was preparing for Lent, this theme came right to mind. Doesn't our world need healing, our society, our relationships and even within our own hearts? Let's pray and focus on this fundamental theme of Jesus as a healer.

I'd invite you to be attentive to the events listed on the annual Lent flyer. This can be found on our website and the Friday Weekly Update. Be sure to subscribe: <https://www.stthomas-church.org/flocknote>

You'll see the weekly Stations of the Cross each Friday of Lent at 7pm, regularly scheduled and additional times for Reconciliation, dates for the annual Lent Museum, and several other opportunities to focus our hearts in prayer. Please mark on your calendar a very special event featuring Francesca LaRosa who composes each of our responsorial psalms at Mass, she'll be leading us in a powerful Stations of the Cross on Monday, March 16 at 7pm. This is a family-friendly event and I'll encourage all of us to attend.

Let us encourage one another along the way. May this Lent be a time of renewal, forty days in which we allow the Lord to meet us, strengthen us, and heal us. Know of my prayers for you as we walk together toward Easter.

## CATHOLIC CULTURE

### VIRTUES, EXPLAINED! CONNECT WITH TRADITION AND GROW YOUR FAITH UNDERSTANDING

"I believe, in order to understand," said St. Augustine. "And I understand, the better to believe." The virtue of understanding, which is a gift conferred by the Holy Spirit, shows us that there is no such thing as "blind faith." Faith, by its very nature, seeks to better understand the object of that faith. It is important to know that understanding is a process — the Holy Spirit is always willing to give a gift over and over again! "The same Holy Spirit constantly perfects faith by his gifts, so that Revelation may be more and more profoundly understood," we read in Dei verbum, the dogmatic constitution on divine revelation. Understanding is the "food" of faith. We must constantly ask the Holy Spirit for greater and more profound understanding, for though understanding proceeds from faith, it in turn nourishes that faith. "A more penetrating knowledge will in turn call forth a greater faith, increasingly set afire by love," says the Catechism (CCC 158).
