LITURGICAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR JUNE 2025

The Office of Worship provides the following notes regarding liturgical celebrations in the month of June.

Please note that since 1998, the Solemnity of the Ascension has been permanently transferred to be celebrated in place of the 6th Sunday of Easter. This year, the Ascension will be celebrated on Sunday, June 1.

Pentecost will be celebrated on June 8. The paschal candle is to remain in place and lit until after the last Mass on Pentecost Sunday. Following the last Mass, it is to be moved to the baptistry of the church.

June 9, the Monday after Pentecost, is the Memorial of Mary, Mother of the Church. The proper texts for Mass and Liturgy of the Hours are found on the USCCB website. https://www.usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/liturgical-year-and-calendar/mother-of-the-church

June 22 is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). Please note that Eucharistic Processions, Exposition and Benediction are to use the new texts and rubrics found the recently released *Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharistic Mystery Outside Mass*. This ritual book is available from all major liturgical publishers.

Sunday, June 29 is the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, Apostles. This solemnity takes the place of the Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. All regularly scheduled anticipated Masses on Saturday, June 28 and all Masses on Sunday, June 29 are to use the Mass and readings for the Solemnity. Additional evening Masses, such as weddings, celebrated on Saturday, June 28 may use different reading and Mass formulae.
