
Help us to recognize the gift of human life as a sign of hope in our world.

St. Charles Borromeo Respect Life Ministry

The Ministry hosted an "End-of-Life" Presentation with the Sisters Servants of Mary and Deacon Gerry Gautrau.

Sr. Angelica Ramos spoke about the Servants of Mary and their Ministry to the Sick. They have 7 sisters who go into the homes of the sick and dying overnight to care for them and pray with them. They have medical training and their services are free of charge.

Sr. Angelica described their ministry as being like Mary at the foot of the cross with Jesus. Much of the grace of their ministry is in just being there so that the sick and dying are not alone. She said it is very beautiful and peaceful spiritually to be with those who are soon to be with God.

Aloma Lykes, a lay member of the Fraternity of Lay Sons and Daughters of St. Maria Soledad, spoke about how the Servants of Mary lovingly ministered to her husband as he was dying in 2018, and how this led to her joining the sisters in their ministry to the sick as a lay person. She gave her testimony about how her work with this ministry is spiritually fulfilling to her and to those to whom she ministers.

The lay fraternity currently has 13 lay members and is looking to form a new class. The lay If you want to help the sisters short of becoming a lay fraternity member, they also need volunteers to drive them to and from the homes of their patients when the families cannot provide transportation.

The sisters also asked for our prayers for their ministry and for more vocations to their Congregation.

Woman's New Life Clinic is a life-affirming medical and mental health clinic providing free and low-cost care for all women.

Services:

- Free unplanned pregnancy support, including ultrasounds, professional counseling, abortion pill reversal, and more
- Free professional counseling for postpartum depression, pregnancy loss, and past abortion
- Instruction in Fertility Awareness-Based Methods
- Low-cost women's health care, including well-woman care, STD testing and treatment, urgent gynecologic care, prenatal care (up to 20 weeks), and Restorative Reproductive Medicine
