How different we are from the Apostles who took nothing when they ventured out to serve God. Today, we make our life's journey more difficult because of all the material baggage that we drag along. When we really put God first in everything and put money and possessions second, we experience more freedom to joyfully serve God and others.

LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Every Catholic shares in Christ's mission when we were baptized. We became members of his body, that same body that reaches out to men and women in every age in order to lead them to God. That's the mission Jesus gave his apostles in today's Gospel: he sent them to reach out to others with Christ's good news of salvation. In fact, the very word

"apostle" comes from the Greek word meaning: "to be sent." Every Christian shares in this "apostolate." Every Christian is sent out to bear witness to Christ, to bring his wisdom and his healing touch to those who are in need, spiritually and physically. Under the supervision of our bishops (the successors to these first Twelve Apostles), we are all called to spread the Kingdom, to be agents of evangelization. Therefore, the missionary instructions that Christ gives to his first followers apply, in analogous ways, to all his followers, us included. These instructions can be summed up in two words: trust and perseverance. Besides the clothes on their backs, the Apostles are only supposed to bring a walking stick and their sandals. Every need they have along the way will be met, but it will be met by God's providence, not by their own self-sufficiency: they are to trust in God to sustain their efforts. The walking stick and the sandals symbolize a determination to continue moving forward, to persevere in their efforts to fulfill God's will. They must not give up. Even when they face opposition, persecution, and a cold welcome (which they will - Christ leaves no room for doubt about that), they are not to be deterred; they are to persevere. Trust and perseverance - two key qualities of the Christian missionary (and we are all Christian missionaries, in one way or another) whose relevance will never run out. The main enemy of trust and perseverance is fear. Fear is to the Christian what kryptonite is to Superman: it saps our strength, so that we can no longer fulfill this mission of being Christ's witnesses in the world. Perhaps what we are most afraid of is what other people will think of us. When we're at a restaurant and the food arrives, we feel self-conscious about saying the blessing: What will everyone think of us? When we're at work and our co-workers are gossiping, making vulgar jokes, or even cooking the books, we are afraid that if we don't join in they will start gossiping about us. When our buddies sneak off to "experiment" with drugs, drinking, and sex, we are afraid that our popularity will suffer unless we go along with them. This fear of what other people will say about us is a real fear. And God knows that it's hard for us to overcome it.

But with his grace we can, as today's Readings show us. In the First Reading, Amos, a chosen prophet, was rejected by the very people that God sent him to. They refused to listen to his prophecy, insulted him, and sent him packing. And yet, he was a true prophet, beloved and chosen by God. And Jesus, when he gives his instructions to the Apostles in today's Gospel, actually tells them how to behave when people reject them - he knows ahead of time that it's going to happen! God is well aware that faithful Christians will not always receive a warm welcome in this fallen world. But he calls us to be faithful anyway, to trust and persevere in what is right and good even when it is not popular, because, as today's Psalm reminds us, that's how we will "see God's kindness and experience his salvation."

CARTA DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

Queridos Feligreses,

Cada católico comparte la misión de Cristo cuando es bautizado. Nos convertimos en miembros de su cuerpo, ese cuerpo mismo que llega a hombres y mujeres de todas las edades con el fin de conducirlos a Dios. Que es la misión que Jesús dio a sus apóstoles en el Evangelio de hoy: los envió a anunciar a otros las buenas noticias de Cristo y de la salvación. De hecho, la palabra "apóstol" viene de la palabra griega que significa: Todo cristiano comparte este "apostolado". Todo cristiano es enviado a dar testimonio de Cristo, a llevar su sabiduría y su toque sanador a aquellos que están en necesidad, espiritualmente y físicamente. Bajo la supervisión de nuestros obispos (los sucesores de estos primeros doce apóstoles), todos estamos llamados a extender el Reino, para ser agentes de Evangelización. Por lo tanto, aplicarán las instrucciones misioneras que Cristo da a sus primeros discípulos, de manera análoga, a todos sus seguidores, nosotros incluidos. Estas instrucciones pueden resumirse en dos palabras: confianza y perseverancia. Además de la ropa a sus espaldas, los apóstoles sólo debían para llevar un bastón y sus sandalias. Todas las necesidades que tienen a lo largo de la jornada de alguna manera serán resueltas, pero se cumplirá por la Providencia de Dios, no por su propia autosuficiencia: van a confiar en Dios para sostener sus esfuerzos. El bastón y sandalias simbolizan una determinación de seguir avanzando perseverar en sus esfuerzos para cumplir las cosas de Dios. No deben darse por vencidos. Incluso cuando se enfrentan a una fría bienvenida, la persecución y la oposición (que lo harán - Cristo no deja duda al respecto), no deben ser disuadidos; deben perseverar. Confianza y perseverancia - dos principales cualidades del misionero cristiano (y somos todos misioneros cristianos, en una u otra manera) cuya relevancia nunca terminara. El principal enemigo de la confianza y la perseverancia es el miedo. Miedo al cristiano como Superman tiene miedo al kryptonita: agota nuestra fuerza, para que ya no podemos cumplir esta misión. Testigos de Cristo en el mundo. Tal vez lo que tememos más es a lo que otras personas pensarán de nosotros. Cuando estamos en un restaurante y llega la comida, nos sentimos acomplejadas para hacer la bendición de los alimentos: ¿qué pensarán de cada uno de nosotros? Cuando estamos en el trabajo y nuestros compañeros dicen chismes, haciendo bromas vulgares, o incluso cocinar los libros, tememos que si no nos unimos vayan a empezar chismes sobre nosotros. Cuando nuestros amigos furtivamente apagados a "experimentar" con drogas, alcohol y sexo, tememos que nuestra popularidad va a sufrir si no vamos con ellos. Este miedo a lo que otras personas dirán sobre nosotros es un temor real. Y Dios sabe que es difícil superarlo.

Pero con su gracia todo lo podemos, como las lecturas de hoy nos muestran. En la primera lectura, Amós, un profeta elegido, fue rechazado por las personas a las que lo envió Dios. Se negaron a escuchar su profecía, le insultaron y lo ignoraron. Y sin embargo, fue un profeta

verdadero, amado y elegido por Dios. ¡Y Jesús, cuando él da sus instrucciones a los apóstoles en el Evangelio de hoy, realmente les dice cómo comportarse cuando las personas los rechazan - él sabe antes de tiempo que va a pasar! Dios es consciente de que los cristianos fieles no siempre recibirán una cálida bienvenida en este mundo caído. Pero él nos llama a ser fieles, confiar y perseverar en lo que es justo y bueno aun cuando no eres popular, porque, como nos recuerda el Salmo de hoy, es cómo vamos a "ver la bondad de Dios y experimentar su salvación."
