
We gather before our monthly meeting @ 6:30 p.m. to recite the Rosary. All are invited

At our November meeting we will be filling and wrapping shoe boxes with items (full-sized items are preferred over travel size) to give to the Seafarers. Crew sizes average 22 seafarers to gift per ship and there are 400+ ships. These ships represent more than 60 different countries! Shoeboxes are donated by over 150 churches, individuals, and organizations such as Catholic Daughters Courts.

Our Court's goal is 30 boxes which represent the size of our Court.

Remember: to bring 1 extra empty shoe box, either plastic, or cardboard for filling at November meeting. Don't forget the tape, scissors, and tissue paper for packing. Wrapping paper will be provided...



#### NOTE: Full-sized items are much preferred over small travel size. Please no liquid soap or bar soaps

You may fill your own shoe box & bring to the meeting OR bring extra items from the list to be placed in boxes at the meeting as a group project.


