

# Saint of the Month - Saint Lucy Feast Day December 13 Patroness of Eyesight


Saint Lucy is a greatly beloved third century
Italian martyr. Her mother suffered for many years from a blood disease. When help could not be found, Lucy told her mother the story of the woman in the Bible who had been healed of her illness when she touched the hem of Jesus' robe. Lucy told her mother to touch the tomb of Saint Agatha, and that if she did this, her mother would be healed.

Lucy and her mother went to Saint Agatha's tomb. They touched it and prayed all night, before falling asleep. Saint Agatha appeared to Lucy while she slept, and called her "Sister." She revealed that Lucy's mother would be healed and that Lucy herself would one day give her life for Our Lord. Lucy's mother was healed instantly, and she allowed Lucy to give her wealth to the poor and to consecrate her virginity to Christ.

A young man to whom Lucy had been promised in marriage accused her as a Christian, and the Roman governor had her eyes gouged out. God miraculously restored Lucy's eyesight, and the governor then set her on fire. Again, God saved her. Finally, Lucy was martyred with a dagger. She was true to Jesus to the end.


