From the Pastor's Desk

This week we will begin our celebration of Holy Week, the most solemn and important time in the Church's year. We end our observance of Lent. We celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper at which Jesus gave us the Eucharist and the Priesthood. We remember Jesus' death on the Cross of Good Friday. We spend Holy Saturday remembering Jesus' time in the tomb. This is a sad time, but one filled with hope because, after sunset that evening, we celebrate the most beautiful liturgy of the entire year: the Easter Vigil. Then, along with Easter Sunday Masses, we remember the fact that Jesus didn't stay in that tomb, but instead conquered death itself, for the sake of us all.

To fully enter into this beautiful week of liturgies, I encourage everyone to attend the Mass on Thursday night, a Good Friday Service, and most importantly, the Easter Vigil. Even if you must visit a church that's not your "home," it's worth the drive. By attending all three you will journey with Jesus from the Last Supper to the cross, the tomb, and his resurrection.

Please note, also, that there will be no Eucharistic Adoration on Good Friday morning in Strasburg.
