PASSION PLAY AND PILGRIMAGE WITH FR. JOSEPH JOHNSON

PLAN A ONCE-IN-A-LIFETIME PILGRIMAGE FOR SUMMER 2022

Father Joseph Johnson will lead a special 11-day pilgrimage to Austria and Bavaria next July 19–29, 2022, for the world-famous "Passion Play" that takes place every ten years in Oberammergau! In 1633, after months of suffering and death from the plague, the villagers swore an oath that they would perform the "Play of the Suffering, Death, and Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ" every ten years. Starting in Vienna, we will travel along the Danube River, visit Salzburg (of "Sound of Music" fame and Mozart's hometown), Munich, as well as many picturesque villages and abbeys along the way. We will visit Marian shrines, a Eucharistic miracle, the tombs of several saints, and the birthplace of Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI. We will also see the famous castle of Neuschwanstein which served as the inspiration for the Disney castle.

Deadline to register is this Wednesday, June 30, 2021, as there are limited tickets available and must be reserved a year



in advance!
