The event will be located in the St. Peter and Paul room in the Parish Center of the school. Enter through the portico doors.



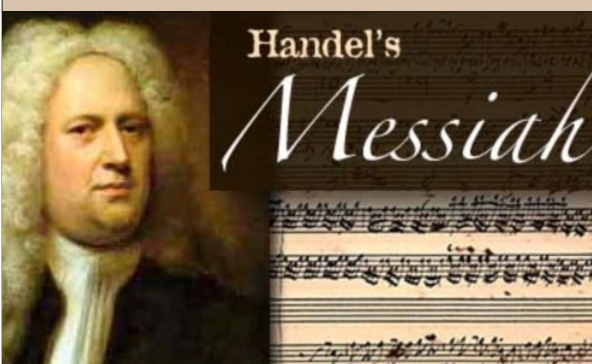

Holy Family Church is privileged to host an annual Advent-tide concert featuring George Fredrich Handel's *Messiah* with professional musicians.

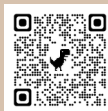
This beautiful concert features a professional orchestra, professional soloists, and our talented Parish Choir and *Schola*. It usually runs about one and a half hours.

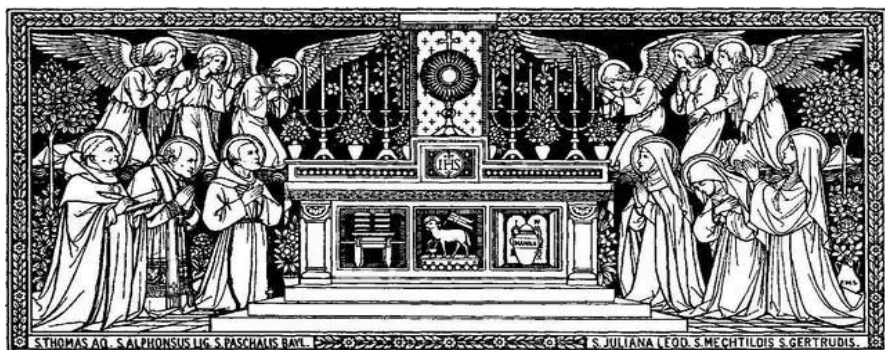
