Exhibit will be available in Crusader Hall at Holy Family Academy. Enter through portico doors of the school driveway.

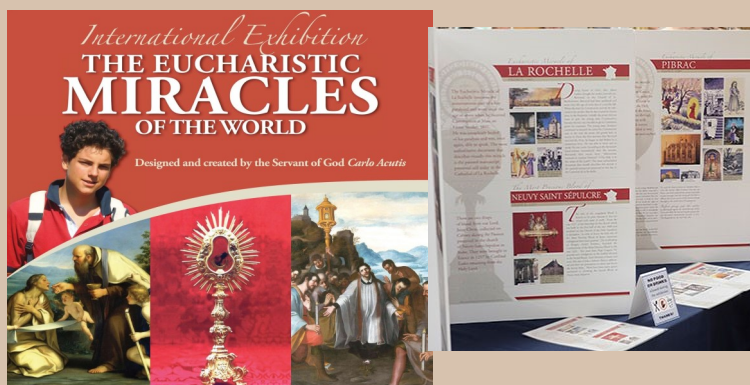
