Music for Funeral Liturgies at Holy Family Catholic Church

Updated: March, 2025

This pamphlet is intended to share with you, the family of the deceased, what is musically done here at Holy Family. The one you mourn today worshipped at a parish known for putting a lot of intentional thought and effort into the Sacred Liturgy, with sacred music being a prominent part of this effort. In keeping with the Church's teachings, we have some beautiful and faithful customs and traditions here which have served us well. This faithfulness does not negate the sadness felt during this time, but points us instead towards a prayerful hope in the mercy and love of God.

Please look through this pamphlet and choose the music from the options given or, if you'd rather, the option to defer these decisions to the Director of Sacred Music, in consultation with the pastor, is also available to you. A selection sheet for you to indicate your musical decisions is on the back page. Please know of our prayers for you and your family.

At the beginning of the Funeral Mass, upon the ringing of the sacristy bell, all sing the Processional Hymn as the altar servers and priest process from the sacristy to the cross aisle (or to the front of the altar in the event of a cremation). The usual selection is *O God, Our Help in Ages Past*; three other options are *Be Thou My Vision*, *Jesus, Lord, Have Mercy*, and *Jesus, Lead the Way*. The lyrics and links to these pieces can be found on the following pages.

Then, after a brief introductory prayer at the casket and once the pall is placed over it or the cremated remains, the cantor(s) sing the Requiem Introit. The Introit is a brief Gregorian chant which says: *Eternal rest give to them, O Lord; and let perpetual light shine upon them* (Ps 64: 2-3). *A hymn to you is fitting, O God in Zion, and a vow made to you in Jerusalem; hear my prayer, all flesh comes to you.* (4 Esdras 2: 34, 35).

After the First Reading, the Cantor leads the congregation in the singing of the Responsorial Psalm, which is usually Psalm 23 – *The Lord is my Shepherd*. The two other options are Psalm 25 – *To You, O Lord, I Lift Up My Soul* and Psalm 27 – *The Lord is My Light and My Salvation*. The lyrics are on the following pages.

After the Second Reading, the Cantor leads the congregation in the singing of the Gospel Acclamation.

For the *Holy, Holy/Sanctus* and the *Lamb of God/Agnus Dei*, either Latin or English can be chosen.

As Father is receiving Holy Communion, we always sing a brief Gregorian chant which says: *May eternal light shine upon them, O Lord, in the company of Your saints for all eternity, for You are full of goodness.*

At the conclusion of the Funeral Mass, the chanter(s) sing the traditional *In Paradisum* in either Latin or English. The text: May angels lead you into paradise; upon your arrival, may the martyrs receive you and lead you to the holy city of Jerusalem. May the ranks of angels receive you, and with Lazarus, once a poor man, may you have eternal rest.
