Bake-Off Rules

Theme: Oreo. Peanut butter. Banana. Use 1, 2, or all 3

Eligibility

Open to anyone in the parish, including kids.

Each participant must register and pay the \$5 entry fee per item by the deadline.

Categories

Any type of baked good is accepted. (e.g., cakes, cookies, pies, breads, puddings, muffins, biscuits, cupcakes).

Participants may enter one or multiple times (with \$5 entry fee per item).

Entry Requirements

All entries must be homemade. No store-bought or pre-made mixes.

Submit the entire item (whole cake, pie, or bread) or two dozen of baked item (cookies, muffins, scones).

Each entry must be labeled with the name of the dish and any allergens.

Cleanliness and hygiene must be maintained.

The remainder of unjudged portions will be sold in the Sweet Treats tent.

Judging Criteria

Judges will score entries based on:

Taste (flavor, texture, freshness)

Presentation (appearance, creativity)

Originality (ingredients or techniques)

Adherence to Theme (extra "brownie" points for using all three theme ingredients!)

Judges

A panel of Fr. Moriarty, Fr. Brent and an impartial judge

Timing

Entries must be submitted by noon on Saturday, 08/06, in the Nazareth House.

Late entries may be disqualified.

Allergy & Dietary Info

Participants must list all ingredients.

Clearly mark entries with common allergens (nuts, dairy, gluten, etc.).

Prizes

Cash prizes awarded for $\mathbf{1}^{st}$, $\mathbf{2}^{nd}$, and $\mathbf{3}^{rd}$ places.

The total number of entries in the bake-off will determine the amount of cash prizes.
