School and church security has been at the top of our minds since last week. We have been making plans for increased security measures to shore up those identified weak points which will allow us to grant peace of mind to our community members.

We are issuing tighter controls on access to our church building during the times that the school is attending Mass and will also be providing an increased security presence before, during, and after Mass.
