

### **CATHOLIC EXPONENT**

As usual, there is ample wisdom in the Scripture readings for this Sunday, but much of it seems difficult – even more so than usual. Does David's restraint, as depicted in First Samuel, against King Saul, who was persecuting him, seem foolish rather than virtuous? And the Gospel reading from Luke telling of Jesus' Sermon on the Plain – with its instructions to love our enemies, turn the other cheek, and do good to those who hate us – strike us as disastrously naïve? Such counter-cultural counsel seems at odds with the message that our society sends us about "watching your back" and "looking out for No. 1." We hear the redemptive words of Jesus at Sunday Mass but we have to live in the larger world the rest of the week.

That is the blessing of the Catholic Exponent, our diocesan newspaper. Through its news, commentary, Scripture reflections, and adult faith formation, the Exponent reminds us of the wisdom of our faith and helps us discern how to apply that wisdom in our day-to -day lives.


You are cordially invited to attend the Lenten series The Way: Walking in the Footsteps of Jesus - Youth Study Edition by Adam Hamilton.

### Dear Parishioner/s

We are only 11 days from Ash Wednesday so it seems appropriate to provide you with some guidelines regarding Ash Wednesday. As you recall, last year we were asked to sprinkle ashes to avoid any contact. In the latest correspondence from the diocese, we are asked to resume traditional distribution of ashes on Ash Wednesday. The latest directives from the Office of Worship states:

Recent postings on liturgical discussion websites have indicated that most dioceses are returning to the regular practice of signing ashes on the individual's forehead since COVID transmission is respiratory and not touch-based.

As a result, Bishop Bonnar has decided that parishes within the diocese return to the regular familiar way for the imposition of ashes this year...saying the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal and signing individuals on the forehead. Ashes <u>may not</u> be self-imposed; they are always given by a minister.

Should the Congregation and/or USCCB issue new guidance in this matter it will be passed on to you.

The current CDC guidance for face coverings remains. Fully vaccinated persons, although not required or mandated, are encouraged to wear a face covering. Unvaccinated persons are still required to wear face covering.

Finally, please remember that the reception of ashes is not mandatory or an obligation. The faithful should be reminded it is their own internal disposition and intention to repent and start over that is the best fruit of Ash Wednesday. Ashes are an external sign of that internal reality. They may enter into Lent with a repentant heart even if they decide that receiving ashes is not the right thing for them this year.

Therefore, we will be signing ashes on foreheads at all the services and Masses in all three parishes. Since Fr. Matt and I are responsible to three parishes, here is the schedule for all the masses and prayer services with distribution of ashes for our parishes.

8:30 am - Mass (School) - Holy Family - Fr. Martin




