





AS SCHOOL BELLS BEGIN TO RING . . . and, unfortunately, summer begins to wind down, it is time to move into a new gear. Starting Monday, September 5, Labor Day, we will resume daily mass Monday through Friday. We will have daily mass each day of the week. There may well be a day or two here or there where I will be gone, those are not real common, so that, for most weeks we will be having daily mass Monday through Friday. HOWEVER, and this is my one big change for the months of August and September, daily mass will be at 8:30am rather than 9:00am. I checked with the school and there will be no problem when the students are attending mass if it begins at 8:30am and there is certainly no reason that the rosary can't be prayed after the conclusion of the mass instead of before mass begins so daily mass will be at 8:30 am and this change will begin Monday, September 5 . . .
