A Note From The Pastor

I Will Get In Trouble. . . especially with Father DeLucia if I don't begin with the most important date of this coming week which is this Monday, October 31, Halloween. All I need do is survive one more day and then all of the Halloween hoopla will be concluded. All the best to young and to old who are celebrating tomorrow. After the big day on Monday, we do have a few other important dates that I want to remind everyone about. Tuesday, November 1, 2022, is the Solemnity of All Saints, a holy day of obligation. Masses for All Saints Day – which we know is the root of Halloween, that is All Hallows Day, the eve of which is Hallows Eve or Halloween – masses for All Saints Day will be celebrated at 8:30am in Saint Nicholas Church and at 4:00pm in Holy Trinity Church. Join us on the holy day. The next day, this Wednesday, November 2, 2022, is the Commemoration of All of the Faithful Departed, All Souls Day. Our regular daily mass for All Souls Day will be at 8:30am in Saint Nicholas Church and then, in the evening, at 6:00pm, also in Saint Nicholas Church, we will have our annual Memorial Mass for all of the departed of Christ Our Savior Parish in the past year. Sponsored by the Parish Nurses, this is a special remembrance of those who have gone before us this past year. Join us in this annual Memorial Mass. Next weekend, then, we will take part in the National Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military. The Archdiocese for the Military provides pastoral care for the men and women serving in the United States Armed Forces as well as others being served by military organizations or serving overseas. This particular collection is only taken up once every three years. Help support the men and women who need the service of the Catholic Church as they give service to our country. Archdiocese for Military Services Collection

Our parish will take up the Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS), next weekend, a collection approved by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops to be taken every three years. The AMS provides pastoral care to Catholic men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S. Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Centers, or who work for the federal government beyond U.S. borders - including those from our own parish and diocese. The AMS does not receive any funding from the government or military, and has no parishes from which to receive a weekly assessment. 
Dear Friend in Christ,

Did You Know?

- Without the AMS there would be no Catholic chaplains. The AMS is the only Catholic diocese in the United States responsible for endorsing priests to serve as military chaplains and for the Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Centers.
- AMS faithful are the men and women serving in the United States Armed Forces, enrolled in U.S. Military Academies, undergoing treatment at a Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center, working in civilian jobs for the federal government beyond U.S. borders - and their families.
- Programs and services readily available in other U.S. diocese, and vital to the men, women, and children served by this Archdiocese, include *Evangelization and Catechesis*, *Sacramental Records*, *Tribunal*, *Vocations*, and the *pastoral care of Veterans*.
- The AMS is the Archdiocese for the Military Services, not of the Military Services. This is an important distinction, as it receives no funding from the U.S. Government or U.S. Military and has no parishes from which to receive a weekly assessment. Instead, it must rely on the generosity of individuals, foundations, and organizations whose values and priorities align with its mission, programs and services.
- The AMS Co-Sponsored Seminarian Program is the only U.S. Vocations Program that provides priests to serve as military chaplains, and also to serve in parishes and dioceses across the country that struggle with their own critical shortage of ministers.
- In 2021, the number of sacraments celebrated for AMS faithful included 1,428 baptisms, 975 confirmations, 1,070 first Holy Communions, and 192 marriages.

AMS Coat of Arms

The coat of arms of the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA is divided into three sections, one in red, one in silver or white, and one in blue – the traditional colors of the United States. In the uppermost portion, there is an American Bald Eagle holding in each claw the universal symbol of peace, a green olive branch. In the middle portion, there is a silver cross on the outline meridians of the earth.



In the lowest, the red portion of these arms, are the gold and silver crossed keys of Saint Peter. The composition of the arms conveys the message and mission of the Archdiocese for the Military Services – to be Americans bearing peace; to proclaim Christ all over the world; and to carry out the mission of the Church to offer healing through the forgiveness of sins.

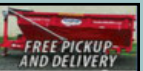

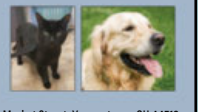
