A Note From The Pastor

Wearin' of the Green. . . This coming Friday we celebrate Saint Patrick's Day. Bishop Bonnar has given the Diocese of Youngstown a dispensation so that everyone is permitted to eat meat on March 17, 2023, even though we are in Lent. I was looking forward to exercising my prerogative as the pastor of Christ Our Savior Parish to give the parish dispensation – a pastor has so little power and then the Bishop goes and upstages one of the few left to the pastor! – but, in any event, please feel free to eat that corned beef while you are drinking that green beer! Hope everyone has a great Saint Patrick's Day! Next Sunday, March 19, 2023, Christ Our Savior Parish will host the second of our area communal Lenten Penance Services here at Saint Nicholas Church at 3:00pm. This will be the final "extra" opportunity that the parish will have to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance prior to Easter. (The regular Saturday time will remain clear up until the Saturday prior to Palm Sunday. There is no celebration of the Sacrament of Penance on Holy Saturday.) Join us next Sunday. We will prepare ourselves to celebrate the Sacrament with a short prayer service and then once you have finished your confession you will be free to leave. 
Please save the date for a Lunch and Learn event to promote the newly developed Office of Peace and Justice, and to learn what that means for our local community and the Diocese of Youngstown.
