We celebrate the 13 Tuesdays, a Novena, in honor of St. Anthony of Padua, the Miracle Worker. A Novena is a specific time set aside on a regular basis to focus in prayer on specific intentions. Saint Anthony is our "partner" in prayer and a channel for God's wonders to bring about change and healing. Please come, one and all, and bring your needs to God's care.
