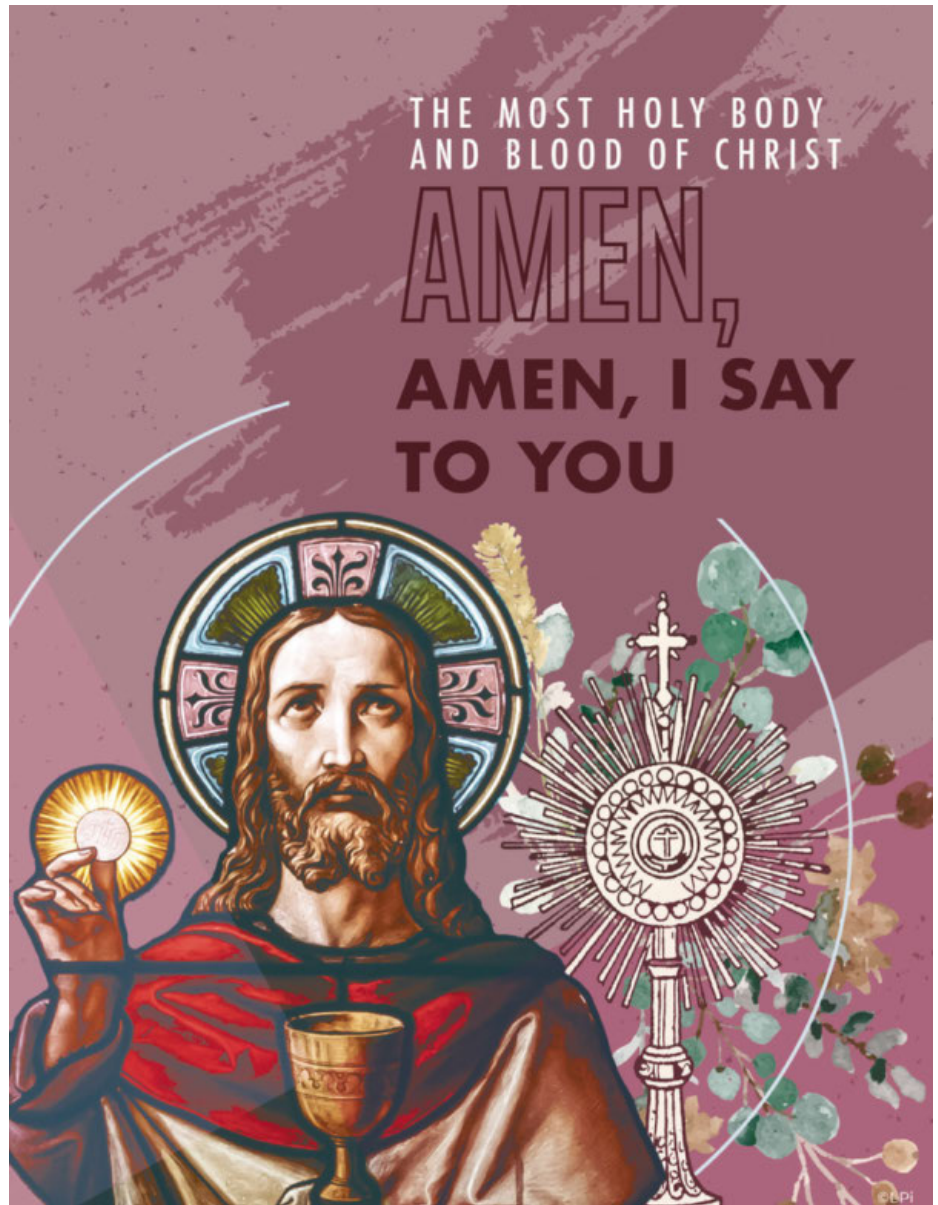

A Note From The Pastor

An Auspicious First . . . will occur next Saturday, June 17, 2023, at Saint Columba Cathedral. The first son of Christ Our Savior Parish will be ordained a priest by Bishop David Bonnar. The Reverend Mr. Robert England, currently a deacon, will be ordained at 10:30am in the cathedral. As we are all well aware, there are fewer and fewer priests ordained every year, not just here in the Diocese of Youngstown, but all over the country. So it is, indeed, a great honor that our parish should have a son of the parish being ordained and given the fact that it is truly a newly created parish gives the soon to be Father England the privilege of being the first from Christ Our Savior Parish. Everyone is invited to attend the ordination next Saturday at Saint Columba Cathedral at 10:30am. If you have never attended an ordination, you should take this opportunity. It is something to see. On Sunday, June 18, Father England will have a First Mass of Thanksgiving in Saint Nicholas Church at 11:00am. Once again, everyone is invited to attend. There will a reception following mass in the lower church and we thank the Altar and Rosary Society and the Holy Name Club for sponsoring the reception. On Saturday, June 17, the day of the ordination, the Knights of Columbus are sponsoring their quarterly Communion mass at 4:00pm in Saint Nicholas Church. Father Joseph Blasko, chaplain for the Knights of Columbus, will be celebrating mass. And in one of those historic coincidences, next Saturday will be the 45th anniversary of the ordination to the priesthood of our retired resident. Father DeLucia was ordained June 17, 1978 also at Saint Columba Cathedral and he celebrated his First Mass of Thanksgiving also in Saint Nicholas Church on Sunday, June 18, however it was also in 1978, forty five years ago. If you want to get in good, tell him he doesn't look like he has been a priest that long!! I am sure he will tell you it certainly feels that long!! Congratulations, early, to Father Robert England. We wish him at least forty five years of priesthood . . . Thanks, Father R.
