

Saint Nicholas School News

Saint Nicholas School is taking registrations for the 2023-2024 school year. Come and check out what our school has to offer. Edchoice Scholarship applications open up on February 1st, 2023. Students who are attending or would be attending an eligible school can apply for the EdChoiceTraditional Scholarship. A list of designated schools can be found on the Ohio Department of Education website under EdChoice Scholarships. EdChoice Expansion Full Scholarships are also available to all families who are at or below 450% of the federal poverty level. A decreasing pro-rated amount dependent on the family's economic status over 450% of the poverty level is then available. Call the school office at 330-755-2128 for more information about our school and scholarship information.

EdChoice Scholarship - As a result of Ohio House Bill 33, signed into law on July 4, 2023, all K-12 students in Ohio are now eligible for an EdChoice Scholarship that can be used toward Catholic school tuition beginning with the upcoming 2023-2024 school year. This includes currently enrolled children as well as any new student beginning their Catholic school experience this fall.

The EdChoice Scholarship will cover a portion, or in some cases, the full cost of a family's Catholic school tuition. A student's specific EdChoice amount depends on the family's 2022 gross adjusted income and family size. The amount could be as much as \$6,165 per year for a student in grades K-8, and \$8,407 per year for a student in grades 9-12.

Please contact the Saint Nicholas School office to learn how to apply for this benefit.

Returning families are already aware of the value of Catholic education. Families interested in pursuing a Catholic education for the first time should contact the school office.

Saint Nicholas School Office will be open August 1st, 2023. First Day of School is Monday, August 21st, 2023.

<u>Can collection for Saint Nicholas School</u> — This is for aluminum beverage cans. No plastic, glass, newspapers, etc. Cans may be crushed. You can leave cans at the garage door or school entrance door. Thank you to all who support the can collection for Saint Nicholas School.
