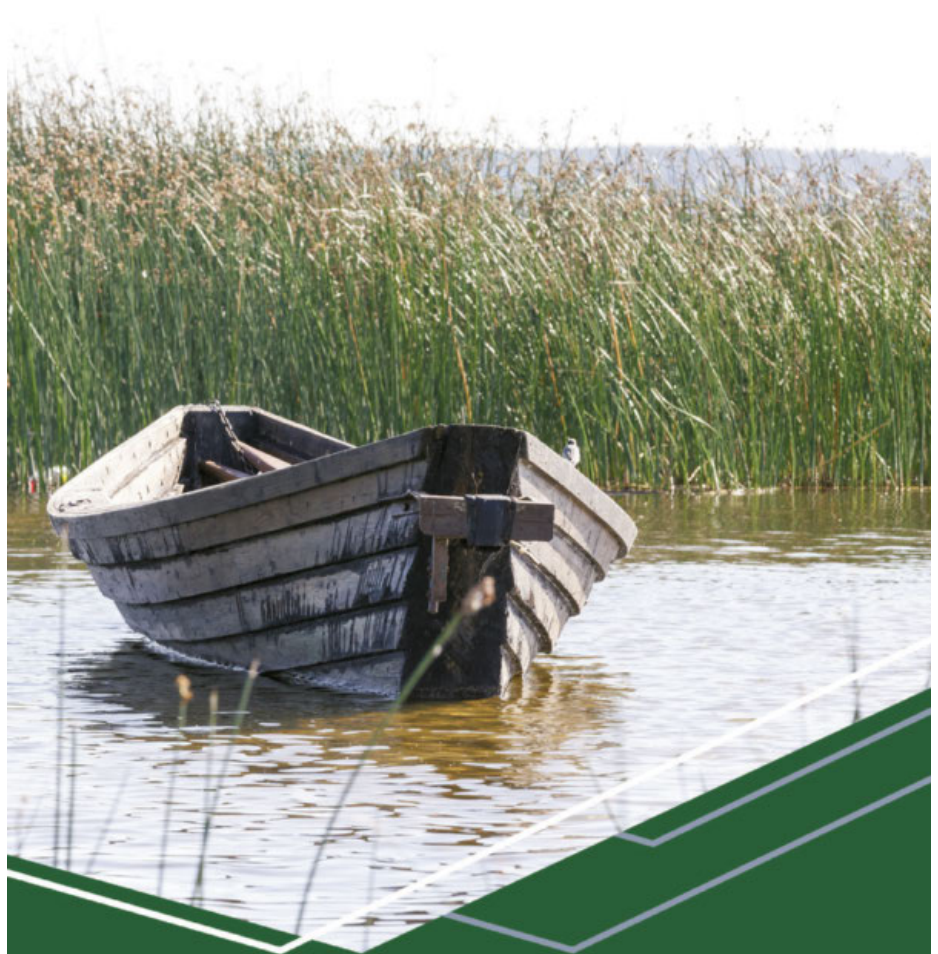

A Note From the Pastor

Another Sign of Our Rapidly Ending . . . summer is that, here we are, on nearly the eve of the Assumption. This Tuesday, August 15, 2023, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In addition to being a holy day of obligation, it also reminds us that we are well into the dog days of summer and that the month of August has reached its midway point. This is the time that much of Europe is off on vacation, although, according to news reports, it has already been very hot in many parts of Europe prior to this usual real hot part of the summer season. Getting back to the important part, please remember to plan to attend mass either Monday afternoon or Tuesday, the eve or the actual solemnity itself. Students who are attending or would be attending an eligible school can apply for the EdChoice Traditional Scholarship. A list of designated schools can be found on the Ohio Department of Education website under EdChoice Scholarships. EdChoice Expansion Full Scholarships are also available to all families who are at or below 450% of the federal poverty level. A decreasing pro-rated amount dependent on the family's economic status over 450% of the poverty level is then available. 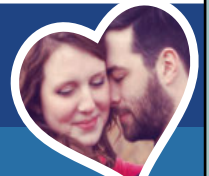
