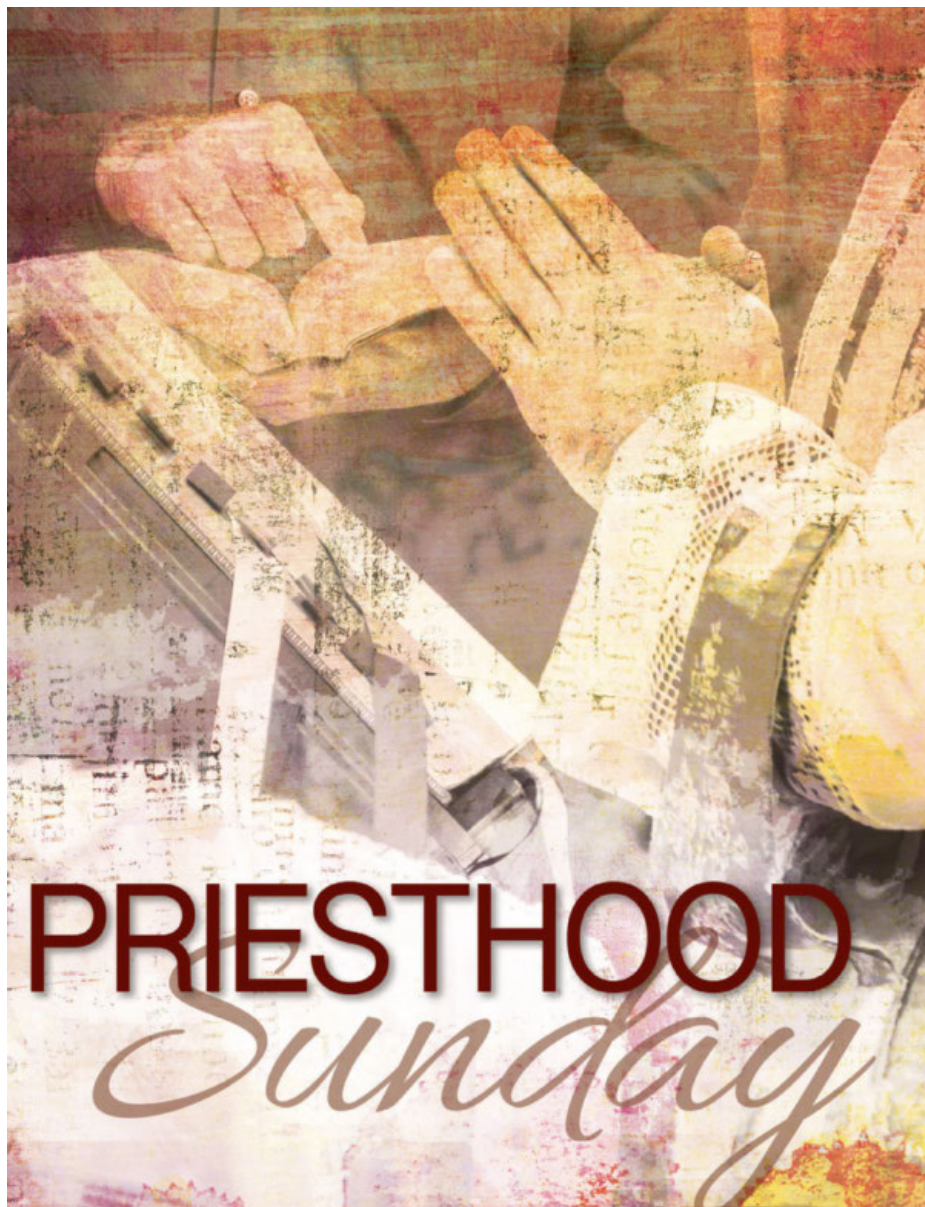

A Note From the Pastor

As I Had Mentioned Previously. . . as we reviewed the numbers of our financial report, the numbers were not bad at all. We have much to be grateful for, especially the generosity of many Christ Our Savior parishioners. I recently shared some not so good figures with the Pastoral Council. As we reviewed the numbers of priests serving in the United States of America, not just in the Diocese of Youngstown, but in the country overall, the numbers are not nearly so good. In 1965, there were 53 million Catholics in the United States of America and there were, at that same time, 36,500 priests, all of which but a small 5% were in active ministry. Fast forward to 2022, the Catholic population in this country increased to 73.5 million, an increase of 20 and a half million. At the same time, the number of priests went down by 12 and a half thousand to 24,000 priests and only two thirds of them are still in active ministry, the rest retired or on sick leave. So while the overall Catholic population went up, the number of priests shrunk dramatically. And, as you would guess, the figures here in the Diocese of Youngstown are almost identical, perhaps even a bit worse. Everyone, every single one of us knows this is not sustainable. I am not, in any way, intimating that I know what the future, immediate or long-term, will look like. That is way, way above my pay grade. What I can say with great certainty is that the future will be different from what we are viewing in September of 2023 but, beyond that, my crystal ball is not working. The best that we can do is to try and be prepared for whatever it is that comes our way. As you would well imagine, this was a big topic of conversation at the Priest Convocation that occurred earlier this month. Lots and lots of talk but there were no conclusions to be found. We will all find out what the future holds together.

On a much brighter note, don't forget the Oktoberfest will be held next Friday and Saturday, September 29 and 30. Good food, good beer, good music, as well as gift card raffle and a baked goods booth should all come together so that a good time will be had by all. I can assure you that I will not be wearing any lederhosen but I am looking forward to seeing you there . . . Thanks, Fr. R.

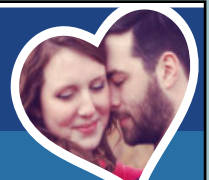
