In order to help people that need special assistance in the winter months, next weekend, our Parish Nurses and the Saint Vincent de Paul Society is sponsoring their annual Winter Coat Drive. After the masses next weekend, October 21 and 22, there will be a collection of new or gently used winter coats and jackets. Please remember that the coats and jackets that are being collected should still have a little "life" in them, we are not looking to get a lot of winter wear that has no more use left in them. There is a special need for children's winter coats and jackets, so, if children or grandchildren have outgrown their winter outerwear, we can certainly use what they can no longer wear. At the same time as the Winter Coat Drive, the Parish Nurses and the Saint Vincent de Paul Society will also be collecting non-perishable food for the Christ Our Savior Food Pantry. Many people are coming to the Food Pantry on Mondays so there is a great need for food stuffs to replenish the food that is given away. In conjunction, then, with the Winter Coat Drive, please bring your food donations as well.

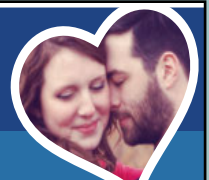
