



The Old Saying Is . . . March comes in like a lion. Well, because of the compressed nature of the Advent season this year I would change that to December is coming at us like a lion. The Fourth Week of Advent lasts exactly one day, that day being the Fourth Sunday of Advent so we really have three weeks to get all of our Advent preparations in. For that reason, next Sunday, December 10, 2023, we will have our one and only Advent Communal Penance Service. This Advent Communal Penance Service will take place at Holy Family Church in Poland at 3:00pm. We used to say that we have it in the afternoon for the benefit of the parishioners who don't like to drive in the dark but, now, it is most of the priests participating who need to be home before nightfall! There will be eight priests celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation at the Advent Communal Penance Service next Sunday. Please be aware that after the Communal Penance Service there will only be three other opportunities for celebrating the Sacrament of Penance so plan now to attend next Sunday at 3:00pm at Holy Family Church in Poland.

This Friday, December 8, is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our national patronal feast day and a holy day of obligation. Masses for the Holy Day will be celebrated at 4:00pm on Thursday, December 7, 2023 at Holy Trinity Church and at 8:30am and 6:00pm on Friday, the feast day itself, at Saint Nicholas Church. Plan now to attend one the three masses for the holy day of obligation.
