

A Note From The Pastor

For Those Who Missed This . . . at the end of the masses this past weekend, I said, "As some of you may have already heard, in accordance with the policies of the diocese, I applied for retirement at age 70 and that request has been approved. My last official day will be June 30. The reason this is being announced so very far ahead of time is that the Diocese will soon be undertaking the process of naming a new pastor, the hope is that one will be appointed within a few months, and this way, rather than hearing a lot of rumors, you will know what is going on. I will be here for quite a while yet, so, you can keep those hearing aids on low." Just a further note – When Bishop Bonnar called me in June of 2022 to ask me to come to Christ Our Savior, I agreed. (The rumor was I was forced – not true!) But I did tell him I would be turning 70 in 2024 and that, at that point, I would request retirement according to the policy of the Diocese of Youngstown. And, that, is, indeed, what has happened. As of June 30, 2024, I will have completed 44 years of fulltime ministry. I will be glad to be of assistance if and when the Diocese should need a little help but I will be glad to lay down all the responsibilities of a parish.

In addition to the usual Lenten activities such as abstaining from meat or coming to daily mass, there will be a lot of other goings on with Lent commencing next week. In announcements and in the bulletin, we have been highlighting the survey that everyone will be encouraged to take, with the start date being Ash Wednesday. Please take a moment to learn all about the survey in this week's bulletin. If you are not savvy with technology, the survey can be done on paper. We certainly hope to hear from many, many parishioners... Thanks, Father R


