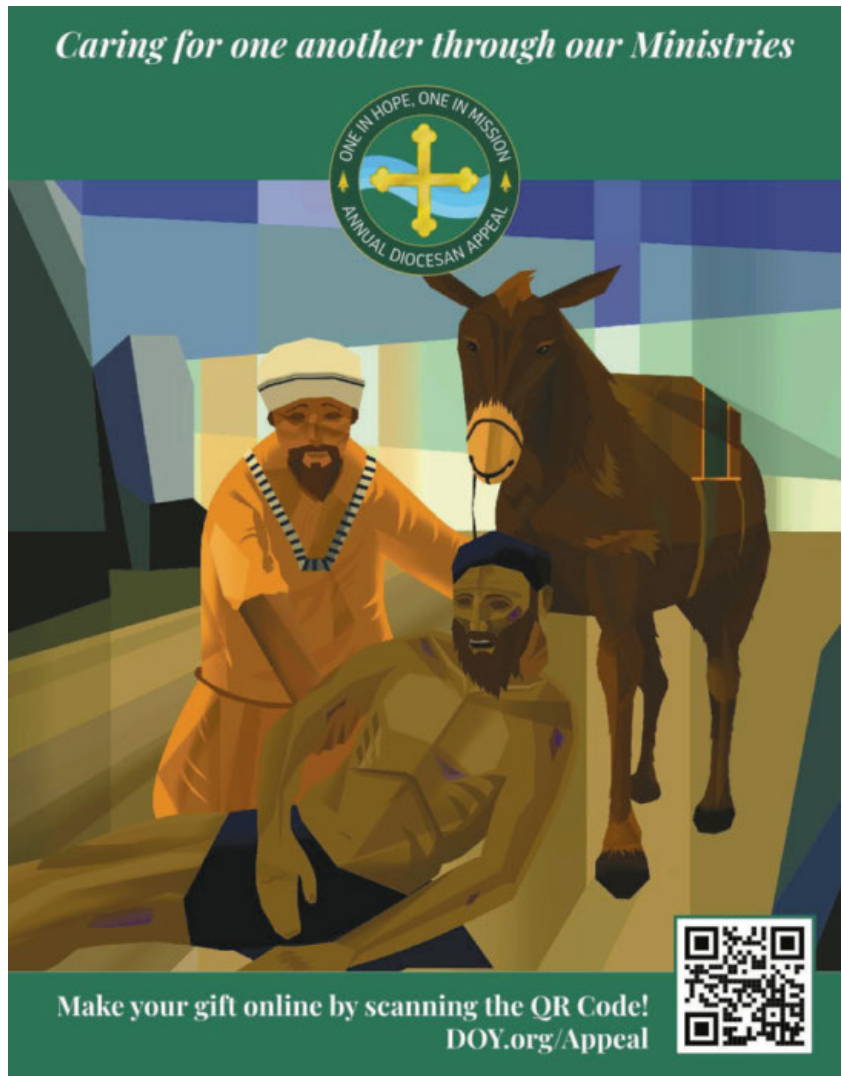

A Note From The Pastor

This Wednesday . . . we start the season of Lent. We begin with Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024. Ashes will be distributed during the masses at 8:30am at Saint Nicholas Church, 12:00noon at Holy Trinity Church and 6:00pm back at Saint Nicholas Church. Ash Wednesday is a day of fast for all Catholic adults between the ages of 15 and 69, fasting refers to only one main meal, two lesser meals and no food in between. Ash Wednesday is also a day of abstinence - no eating of meat - for all Catholics over the age of 7. All of the Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence so those also include refraining from meat. We are accustomed, as well, to "giving something up" for Lent, so, don't forget to prepare to start this Wednesday.

Also, this week, we begin our annual Diocesan Appeal. All of the families of the Diocese of Youngstown are asked to support the work of Catholic Charities as well as the diocesan ministries in this one Appeal. There is not a more important Appeal that comes to us from the Diocese. The annual appeal theme – One in Hope, One is Mission – serves as a powerful reminder that the annual appeal is an opportunity for all Catholics in our diocese to join together as one in mission to make a shared commitment to support the work of the diocese. This commitment serves the needs of our diocese's parishes, schools, and people as well as providing hope and care to our neighbors in need. In today's Gospel story, Jesus cleanses a leper with the words, "Be made clean" (Mark 1:41). The faith of this leper moves God to give him the outward cleanliness he sought. This healing would allow him to re-enter Jewish society, from which he had been cast out.

Jesus says he came that "they might have life and have it more abundantly" (John 10:10). He didn't just come to cleanse the outside, like the Pharisees, who "cleanse the outside of the cup and the dish" (Luke 11:39). He came to renew *all* of us, outside and in.

We need your help to meet the many needs of those around you. Jesus says that, "As to what is within, give alms, and behold, everything will be made clean for you" (Luke 11:41). Jesus says there is a connection between almsgiving and the true cleanness of life which the Jews sought. Small wonder: Almsgiving requires sacrifice. It requires the same spirit of sacrifice that we need to take up our personal cross valiantly. During Lent, Catholics will have an opportunity to reflect on their spiritual life using a survey called the Disciple Maker Index (DMI). The survey provides data for pastors, parish councils, and lay ecclesial ministers to help parishioners grow in their faith. The Catholic Leadership Institute will provide survey results during the Easter season, followed by training for parish leaders. The Diocese of Youngstown is one of only 15 dioceses across the country chosen to participate in this multi-year process of reflection and growth.

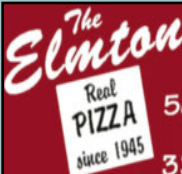
