## A Note From the Pastor

We Have Included . . . a copy of the letter from Bishop Bonnar that I read at all of the masses this past weekend. If you were not there, this is your opportunity to review what the Bishop had to say. In summary, once again, when my replacement is named – don't know when that will be, hopefully soon – when the new pastor of Christ Our Savior Parish is named, he will also be named pastor of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary, Lowellville, at the same time; one pastor but two separate and distinct parishes. Our Lady of the Holy Rosary has already been in this model. For a number of years, they shared their pastor with Saint Paul the Apostle, New Middletown and for the past two years they have shared a pastor with Holy Family, Poland. There will be two separate Parish Councils, two separate Finance Councils and the like, so, this is not a merger. When the new pastor is named, all of the details of what Bishop Bonnar calls a "collaborative unit" will be worked out. Thank you for your patience as we await a new, young vibrant pastor – everything the outgoing pastor is not!!

If you are beginning to make your Easter plans, please take note of the schedule of masses for Easter. On Saturday, March 30, 2024, there is no 4:00pm mass. The Easter Vigil will begin at 7:00pm at Saint Nicholas Church. On Sunday, March 31, 2024, Easter Sunday masses will be at 9:00am at Holy Trinity Church – note the change from the usual 8:00am mass – and the second mass will be at 11:00am at Saint Nicholas Church. As the old saying goes, forewarned is forearmed. In this way, everyone can make their Easter arrangements knowing when to come to mass.

And a GREAT AND HAPPY SAINT PATRICK'S DAY TO ALL WHO ARE CELEBRATING WITH THE WEARIN' OF THE GREEN. For all of the Irish, by birth and by adoption, hope everyone enjoys a most celebratory day. . . Thanks, Father O'Rogers

Dear Father Rogers and Christ Our Savior Parishioners,

As you know, since 2019 our diocese has been engaged in a regional plan centered on living the mission of the Church. Upon my arrival in 2021, I affirmed this plan, and in the past three years we have all worked together to embrace what Pope Francis calls a "missionary option," that is, "a missionary impulse capable of transforming everything, so that the Church's customs, ways of doing things, times and schedules, language and structures can be suitably channeled for the evangelization of today's world rather than for her self-preservation." (*Joy of the Gospel*, #27).

I am grateful for the ways that your parish has embraced this vision in various ways. I know each parish community has been stretched as everyone has needed to share priests, coordinate Mass schedules and parish programs, navigate times of uncertainty and explore new unfolding possibilities for missionary activity and a sense of being one family in Christ. Throughout the diocese, almost all of our parishes are now part of a collaborative unit or exist as a multi-site parish.

Recently, I have received additional consultation and guidance from the Diocesan Presbyteral Council, Clergy Personnel Board, Diocesan Pastoral Council, Diocesan Finance Council, and regional priest deans. They have recommended to me that I form several new parish collaborative units, in which parishes will continue to function as distinct entities but share a limited number of priests and other personnel. These collaborative units will also foster collaboration through coordinated Mass times and additional shared parish programs and activities, some of which are already occurring.

Among these recommendations is that your parish of Christ Our Savior and Our Lady of the Holy Rosary exist as a collaborative unit. I have accepted this recommendation. Your parishes will share a priest and some pastoral activities, while still remaining distinct parishes effective July 1, 2024. Even when parishes have their own identity, parish partnerships remind us that we all share in a common mission as the Church. This partnership and others throughout the diocese help us be intentional about staffing our parishes and responding to the shortage of priests.

Thank you again for your patience and participation as we move forward in pastoral planning. In your collaboration with one another, you are living the mission of the Church. As I pray for you, I also ask for you to pray for me and for all our priests, deacons, and lay ecclesial ministers, that we grow deeper in missionary discipleship. Above all, let us trust in the Spirit, who leads us into deeper mission, "That All May Be One".

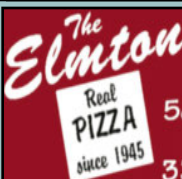
