From Father Mike

Happy Easter! It is a joy to celebrate my first Easter with you all across the pastorate. Each year the Responsorial Psalm for today's Mass is, "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad." (Psalm 118) I've always been confused by this because it makes it sound like we only celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord one day a year, yet we know that it is celebrated every Sunday and experienced daily in our lives. Indeed, this is a great saying to have every day when we wake up, that God has given us another day of life to live for him in joy and gladness. So then we may wonder why we need Easter Sunday at all if we are living daily in the new life of the Resurrection. I would suggest that Easter Sunday is the day we are reminded of the big picture of what God has done for us—that, in the course of human history, love conquered sin and death. When most of the year we may focus on particular aspects of our life as Christians or as church, today we celebrate the ultimate reality that we are participants in Jesus' victory. This Day of Triumph has created by the Lord, and since we could not have defeated evil on our own, all we can do is be glad that God himself has saved us. May this annual celebration of this glorious day make every one of our days glorious and an ongoing occurrence of rejoicing.

¡Felices Pascuas! Es una alegría celebrar mi primera Pascua con todos ustedes en todo el Pastorado. Cada año, el Salmo Responsorial para la Misa de hoy es: "Este es el día del triunfo del Señor". (Salmo 117) Esto siempre me ha confundido porque pareciera que sólo celebramos la Resurrección del Señor un día del año, pero de antemano debemos saber que se celebra cada domingo y se experimenta a diario en nuestras vidas. De hecho, este es un gran pensamiento para tener presente todos los días al despertarnos. Dios nos ha dado otro día de vida para vivir para Él con gozo y alegría. Entonces, pudiéramos preguntarnos ¿por qué necesitamos el Domingo de Pascua si vivimos diariamente la Resurrección? Sugeriría que el Domingo de Pascua es el día en que recordamos el panorama en general de lo que Dios ha hecho por nosotros: que, en el curso de la historia humana, el Amor venció al pecado y a la muerte.
