

HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY

1 Begin with **THE SIGN OF THE CROSS**: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. [and pray **THE APOSTLES' CREED**]: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord; Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell; the third day He rose again from the dead. **He ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty; from there He shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.**

2 On the first bead pray the **OUR FATHER** for the Pope:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. **Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not; into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.**

3 On each of the next three beads pray the **HAIL MARY** for an increase of faith, hope, and love.

Hail Mary, full of grace, The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. **Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now, and at the hour of our death. Amen.**

4 Pray the **Glory Be**: Glory Be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. **As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.**

5 On this bead announce the **1ST MYSTERY** and pray the **OUR FATHER**.

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. **Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not; into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.**

6 On each of the next ten small beads pray the **HAIL MARY** while meditating on the mystery (the set of ten Hail Mary beads is called a decade).

7 Pray the **GLORY BE** and **OUR LADY OF FATIMA** prayer: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. **As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.**

"Oh my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy Mercy."


8 Announce the **2nd mystery** then say the Our Father. Repeat (6) and (7) and continue with the **3rd, 4th, and 5th mysteries** in the same manner.


9 When the **5th** mystery is completed, the Rosary is concluded with the following prayers:

HAIL, HOLY QUEEN, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope. To you do we cry, poor banished children of Eve; to you do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate, your eyes of mercy toward us, and after this our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of your womb, Jesus. Oh clement, Oh loving, Oh sweet Virgin Mary! Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let Us Pray: Oh GOD, whose only begotten Son, by His life, death, and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech Thee, that meditating upon these mysteries of the Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen.

End with the sign of the Cross.





PRAYERS OF THE ROSARY

Sign of the Cross: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
