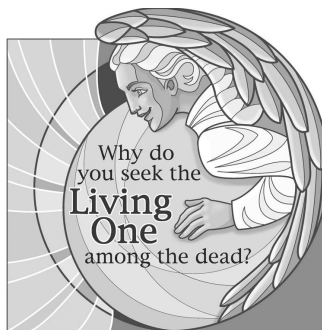

FROM OUR READINGS...



ALLELUIA! Jesus is risen. Jesus is alive. In the first reading, Peter recalls that they hanged Jesus on a tree but on the third day, God raised him from the dead, and He was visible to both the people and the apostles who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.

Our today's psalm exhorts us: "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad."

We are called the Resurrection of our Lord Church, and so for us this is a special family day. The cause of our joy is not that Jesus rose from the dead and returned to the Father. If that were true, Jesus would be very distant from us.

The cause of our joy is that Jesus is with us and has come to stay as he promised: "For a short time you will feel desperate," he told his disciples. "But I shall come again, and I shall be with you all days, even to the end of the world." Jesus is with us all the time.

The cause of our joy is that the resurrection of Jesus is the guarantee of our own resurrection. Jesus assured Martha at the tomb of Lazarus: "*I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me will live even though he dies...*" (Jn 11:25–26).

Jesus was buried at sunset. Darkness was creeping over the earth. He appeared both a victim and a failure. But after three days, Jesus had the last laugh. He resurrected. His resurrection is a powerful proof that He overcame the powers of sin, death, and darkness. Light always overcomes darkness.

The Easter candle in our midst reminds us that Jesus is the light of the world. Jesus says: "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." We are invited to reject everything associated with darkness and evil, and to walk as children of the light.

As we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus, we are invited to remember that death has no final word. Death is the door through which we enter into eternal life. Eternal life has the final word. God's plan for me and for you is not death but eternal life. Happy Easter to all of you.

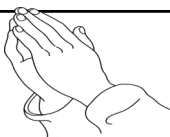
