Auction Ins and Outs

⇒ What is the auction?



The auction is the school's annual fundraiser to help raise funds to assist with school needs including student scholarships, improved technology and increased school safety. The auction consists of an online silent auction, a live auction at the event, a raffle, a dinner and fellowship.

⇒ What is the Raffle?

The raffle is a drawing that awards up to \$10,000 to winners. Raffle tickets are \$100 each with a maximum of 250 tickets sold. The drawing is held at the auction but winners do not need to be present. The first place winner is awarded \$10,000, second \$1,000, third \$500 and fourth \$250. Tickets may be purchased at the school or parish office.

⇒ How can I make an auction item donation or underwrite the costs of the auction?

Donations are still being accepted at the school between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. The list of items to donate is endless but ideas include children's games and books; themed baskets such as a Family Movie Night or Baker's Essentials; outdoor furniture and activities; gift certificates and tickets to concerts and sporting events. Monetary donations to help underwrite the costs of the auction are also needed and may be made at the school office.

⇒ How does the online auction work?

Go to <u>bidpal.net/stpaulauction</u>. You can browse items as they are posted. To place a bid or create a watch list, go to the site and register. You can then create a watch list, bid on items and even set up an auto bid to be sure you get the items you desire. Check out a short video tutorial at <u>onecuase.com/solutions/mobile-bidding-auction-software/how-to-use</u> to learn how mobile bidding works.

⇒ Do I bid online even if I attend the event?

Yes, all bidding for silent auction items is done electronically. If you need assistance with bidding or navigating the auction site, a team of St. Paul alumni will be available to assist you.

⇒ Can I pay with cash or check?

Yes, you can pay with cash or check at the event. However, to expedite your checkout, guests are encouraged to register a credit or debit card and use it to checkout.

What to wear?

⇒ Can I participate even if I cannot attend?

Silent auction items and donation opportunities are available online at <u>bidpal.net/stpaulauction</u>. You will pay for your items online and stop by the school on May 11th between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. to pick up your items.
