Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel: In 1884, Pope Leo XIII, having just celebrated Mass, had a terrifying vision in which he saw Satan approach the throne of God and claimed that, given a century, he could destroy the Church. He was also given a preview of the horrors of the twentieth century which would include two great wars and multiple smaller wars, bloodshed, geno-

cide, and large-scale apostasy from the Faith. In response to these visions, he composed a prayer invoking the protection and intercession of St. Michael the Archangel.

The Pope asked that the shorter version of this prayer be prayed, along with three *Hail Marys* and the *Hail Holy Queen*, after the celebration of every Low Mass, praying for protection of the Church. Later these prayers were also prayed for the conversion of Russia. In the wake of the reforms of the Second Vatican Council, many parishes dropped the public recitation of these prayers, though many of the Faithful continued to pray them privately as part of their thanksgiving prayers after Mass.

About two years ago, Pope Francis, recognizing the many spiritual battles evident within the Church and beyond, asked the Faithful to regularly pray the *Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel*.

At all three parishes in Muncie, starting August 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>, we will begin praying the Prayer to St. Michael after the dismissal (before final hymn) at all Masses. The Catholic Identity Committee, of St. Michael Catholic School, has chosen this translation for our use in Muncie. Copies of this prayer will be included in the worship aids and/or inside the hymnals.



# Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel

St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle.

Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil;

May God rebuke him, we humbly pray;

And do thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls.

Amen.




