Next Week's Reading – Second Sunday in Ordinary Time – January 17, 2021 Year B

First Reading (1 Samuel 3:3b-10, 19) Samuel thought Eli was calling him but then recognized the Lord. He said "Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening." He heard the Lord and followed.

Second Reading (1 Corinthians 6:13c-15a, 17-20) Paul told his friends that their bodies are "members of Christ ... a temple of the Holy Spirit within you." He said, "You are not your own ... Glorify God in your body."

Gospel (John 1:35-42) Andrew sought out his brother Simon to tell him, "We found the Messiah" (the Christ). Jesus met Simon and renamed him Cephas (Peter).
