Next Week's Readings- The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

1st Reading: Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a (167A) Moses reminded the people that for forty years God tested them in the desert. The Lord let them be hungry and fed them manna, showing that God's people do not live by bread alone.

2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 10:16-17 By sharing in the eucharistic bread, Christians, though many, are one body in Christ.

Church Financial Business For many years the Men's Club and the Altar Society have maintained their own separate checking accounts. These accounts were used to deposit the proceeds from their various activities and to pay the expenses related to those activities. At Padre's request, and with the support of the Finance Council, both groups were asked to close these accounts and turn the balance in them over to our Parish. Both groups have complied with this request, with the Men's Club turning over \$2,700 and the Altar Society turning over \$507.66. Going forward, all receipts generated by these groups will be turned into the Parish office and then deposited in the sole Parish checking account. The expenses incurred by these groups in the normal course of their activities will be reimbursed out of their funds. The financial software our Parish uses will enable us to track the receipts and disbursements from each organization separately and for these transactions to be reflected in our monthly financial statements. This change brings our Parish into compliance with the Diocesan Guidelines that prohibit parish affiliated groups from having separate checking accounts. Both of these organizations are an important part of our Parish life and if you are not active in them you are encouraged to do so.
