## Next Week's Readings—First Sunday of Lent

1<sup>st</sup> Reading: Genesis 9:8-15 (23B) After the great flood, God told Noah of the covenant between heaven and earth. Never again would a flood destroy the earth. To mark this covenant, the Lord set up a rainbow in the sky.

2<sup>nd</sup> Reading: 1 Peter 3:18-22 As the ark saved a chosen few in Noah's day, so does baptism by faith save God's chosen today. Baptism is "an appeal to God for a clear conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ."

<u>Gospel: Mark 1:12-15</u> The Spirit sent Jesus to the desert to fast and pray for forty days. Afterwards, Jesus appeared in Galilee proclaiming, "The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."
