### <u>August 24 & August 25 Readings — 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time — Year B</u>

1st Reading: Joshua 24:1-2a, 15-17, 18b (122B) — Joshua told the Israelites they were to decide whom they would serve: the Amorite gods or the Lord who brought them out of Egypt. They agreed to "serve the Lord, for he is our God."

2<sup>nd</sup> Reading: Ephesians 5:21-32 or 5:2a, 25-32 — Paul likened the love of a husband and wife to the love Christ has for the church. As Christ loves the church, so should husbands and wives love each other.

<u>Gospel: John 6:60-69</u> – Jesus' disciples were puzzled by his words. Jesus reminded them "It is the spirit that gives life, while the flesh is of no avail." Simon Peter responded, "You have the words of eternal life."
