November 9/10 Readings – 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time – Year B

1st Kings 17:10-16 (155B) – Elijah the prophet arrived at the city gate and met a poor widow gathering sticks. He asked for water and a bite to eat. She made a little cake from her flour and gave it to him.

2nd Reading: Hebrews 9:24-28 – Christ, the high priest standing before God, was “offered once to take away the sins of many.” He will appear again “to bring salvation to those who eagerly await him.”

Gospel: Mark 12:38-44 or 12:41-44 – Jesus saw a poor widow go up to put all she had into the collection box: a few cents. She put in more than all the others, for she gave from her need while they from their surplus.
