December 21/22 Readings – Fourth Sunday of Advent – Year C

1st Reading: Micah 5:1-4a (12C) – Out of tiny Bethlehem will come one who is to be ruler over all Israel. "He shall stand firm and shepherd his flock ... he shall be peace." 2nd Reading: Hebrews 10:5-10 – God took no delight in holocausts and sin offerings, even those that fulfilled the law.
